In this day-long workshop, we will delve into the writing process for students to choose, write and edit their own authentic first-person stories. What makes a good story? How do you pick what story to share? How do we frame our stories for our intended audience? How is written storytelling different or similar to oral storytelling and how can we write our stories in a way that will be clear and stay true to our own voice? We will explore writing through the lens of digital storytelling and the history that this process has in Adult Basic Education. Participants will practice activities together for script-writing, giving helpful feedback and editing. We will use existing digital stories as examples and review a demonstration of the process of turning the written personal story into a multi- media project. Finally, we will share potential next steps, materials and opportunities for learning more. Throughout the unit, students will follow the stories of four adult education students who own small businesses and will learn about business ownership through videoed interviews with these entrepreneurs. This context-driven unit incorporates digital literacy and academic skills as they are relevant, with a primary focus on topics about managing a business and marketing products or services, as well as the finances of owning a business. Students can apply their learning to decisions as a future small business owner or to their individual lives.During this preconference you will experience the student- driven style of this unit and leave with access to the interviews and all the materials – including materials to use in classes in which internet access is unavailable.
