ELA, Math, and Science: March 13 – April 28, 2023

## MCAA (Multi-State Alternate Assessment)

- ✓ ELA, Mathematics, and Science
- ✓ Administered individually or one-on-one
- ✓ For students with significant cognitive disabilities
- ✓ Writing prompt
- ✓ Student Selector Application to register students for MCAA: October 3 - November 30, 2022
- ✓ Monitoring for the 1% Threshold (if over 1% participation in Alternate Assessment) begins October 3
- ✓ Training for test administrators and test coordinators starts February 27, 2023

- ✓ Operational Field Test: February 1 – March 17, 2023
- ✓ AZ partners with other states in the Collaborative for the Alternative Assessment of English Language Proficiency (CAAELP)
- ✓ Test Coordinators will register eligible students using Student Selector Application October 3 – November 30, 2022
