Specifically, during Breakfast on 6/28/22 production records do not accurately reflect quantities offered; production records indicate 1/2 cup serving of Fruit was planned and served, when 1 cup of Fruit was offered.	Discussed that all required minimum quantities must be offered to all participating children at the beginning and throughout meal services. Additionally, discussed options for offering a variety of items as part of the reimbursable meal or options for adjusting what is offered on each meal service line. Discussed on day of review to ensure all minimum quantities were met, two 1/2 cup servings of strawberries were made available and student had option to decline 1/2 cup serving.
