## AZ'S RESEARCH-BASED SEI MODELS

So, you've chosen an SEI model (or models) for your LEA... **where do you go from here?** Use the checklist below to ensure your LEA meets the *minimum* requirements for EL instruction under federal and state law.

These are the **non-negotiables**:

- ✓ **You must** have your EL students grouped by Proficiency level and/or grade band *to the extent possible* for ELD instruction.
- ✓ **You must** have the minimum number of **Integrated ELD** minutes per selected model(s) scheduled for all ELs (reflected on master, class and/or teacher schedules.)
- ✓ **You must** have the minimum number of **Targeted ELD** minutes per selected model(s) scheduled for all ELs (reflected on master, class and/or teacher schedules.) Remember, this is **protected time for ELs only** with a qualified teacher focused on the ELP Standards!

### PULL-OUT

50 or 60 min/day  
**Integrated**

50 or 60 min/day  
**Targeted**

### TWO-HOUR

100 or 120 min/day of **Targeted** (the rest of the day should be **Integrated**)

### 50-50 DLI

75 or 90 min/day of **Integrated**

25 or 30 min/day of **Targeted**

### NEW-COMER

100 or 120 min/day of **Integrated**

100 or 120 min/day of **Targeted**

The SEI, ESL or BLE endorsement is required of teachers delivering **Integrated** and **Targeted ELD**.

ELD minutes can be met **daily** or **weekly** and do not have to be consecutive.

**Pull-Out** can include pulling small groups of EL students within or pushing an EL Specialist into the mainstream classroom.
