## October Final Allocations

  - Budget additional funds!
- If your application has primary approval on some grants:
  - 1. Submit for primary approval on remaining grants. Note budget balance won't be zero for primary approved grants.
  - 2. Submit to budget your additional funds.

- Neglected count funds Title I-A Set Aside #10

## **SAIPE Census Data**

For Traditional School District (Census Districts)

- Based on the 2020 Decennial Census
- Adjusted each year based on Federal Income tax returns, SNAP benefits, and population estimates

The 2020 dataset for Small Area Income and Poverty Estimates (SAIPE) was used for FY23 grants.

2021 SAIPE is planned for release in December 2022
