

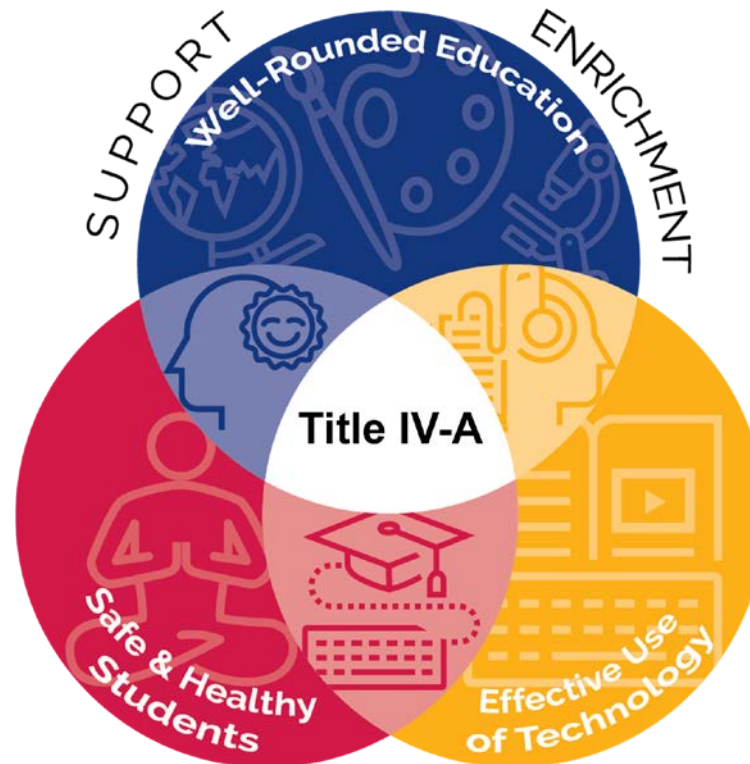

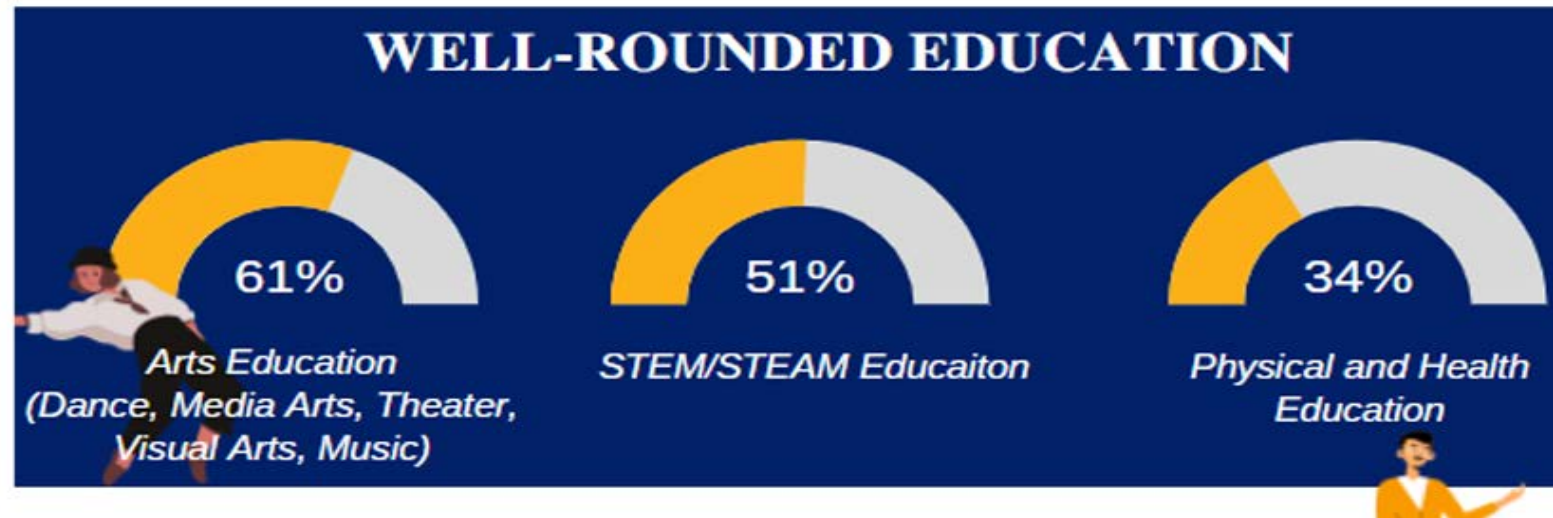
ARTS ED FOR ALL STUDENTS

- ❖ The Arizona Academic Standards in the Arts address grade-by-grade level Performance Standards for students in K-8.
- ❖ The Arizona Academic Standards in the Arts provide three levels of Performance Standards for high school:
 - Proficient = 1 year of study
 - Accomplished = 2-4 years of study
 - Advanced = Honors or college-level study
- ❖ The Arizona Academic Standards in the Arts provide five levels of Performance Standards for Music
