What is **pax** | Good Behavior Game ?


The PAX Good Behavior Game utilizes Evidence-based Kernels to teach **self-regulation** and **positive behavior** as a skill set.

How does the PAX Good Behavior Game Work?


Teachers use the evidence-based strategies in PAX GBG in their daily interactions and management of the classroom




These strategies create a nurturing environment for teaching and learning


AZ PAX Educators Trained During the 21 - 22 school year
