

Can Title I fund this? IT DEPENDS!

The FIVE FACTORS for review:

1. Reasonable and necessary test
2. Aligned to comprehensive needs assessment data and in school and/or LEA Integrated Action Plan
3. Designed to improve student achievement
4. Evidence based
5. Supplement vs Supplant

(1) IN GENERAL.—A State educational agency or local educational agency shall use Federal funds received under this part only to supplement the funds that would, in the absence of such Federal funds, be made available from State and local sources for the education of students participating in programs assisted under this part, and not to supplant such funds.

(2) To demonstrate compliance with paragraph (1), a local educational agency shall demonstrate that the methodology used to allocate State and local funds to each school receiving assistance under this part ensures that such school receives all of the State and local funds it would otherwise receive if it were not receiving assistance under this part.
