Since no performance levels were adopted, state proficiency rates are not available.*

Due to low student counts in reports when disaggregated at the school level, would some of the reports displayed not be FERPA-compliant for a public Governing Board Meeting?

It is always a good idea to check with your LEA regarding FERPA when sharing out data.

Will ACT Aspire scores be added to the public data sets for ADE Accountability?

At this time, ACT Aspire scores will not be added into the public data sets for ADE Accountability because ACT Aspire is being used for Bonus Points for participation only.

Will ACT Aspire be added into the self-reporting for CCRI?

At this time, ACT Aspire will not be added to self-reporting for CCRI. Schools can earn up to 3 bonus points on administering ACT Aspire to Grade 9 students.

The reports shown in the presentation were state-level reports that were posted in PAN.
