- Julie discussed the Released Academic Standards (Not changed just reformatted) AZ Arts Standards Website: <u>Home | Arizona</u> <u>Arts Standards</u>
 - Purpose- additional resources to use within their content and helps bridge gaps.
 - Academic Standards Resources/ Reformatted- new view shows student friendly standards, as well as standards are meant to be easier to implement in classrooms. Also has sample lessons that could be used in the classroom. SEL Opening and Closing rituals (quick ways), just resources to make the standards more usable and guided resources for all Fine Art contents.
