





Teachers Needed to Develop Embedded Academic Crosswalks



EMBEDDED ACADEMIC CROSSWALK COMMITTEES

Some CTE programs have enough academic content to warrant granting academic credit. A committee of CTE teachers and academic specialists work virtually with a facilitator to analyze the CTE program standards for embedded academic content. Once completed, a crosswalk is developed showing the alignment of relevant academic standards to the CTE standards. Meeting dates are to be determined based on committee availability. 


