


**2022 A-F Letter Grade
Accountability System:
Non-Typical Schools Business Rules**

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Non-Typical School Configurations

Schools that serve grades K-12, 1-12, 2-12, 3-12, 4-12, 6-11, etc. utilize both the K-8 and 9-12 models. Students in grades K-8 are used to determine the K-8 total points earned and students in grades 9-12 the 9-12 total points earned. The percentage of students in the A-F Static File in grades K-8 and 9-12 is used to weight the points to assign the school one overall percentage. To obtain one letter grade the following calculation is done:

$$\text{Non - Typical School Configuration Letter Grade} = \frac{\left(\frac{(K - 8 \text{ Total Points} * K - 8 \text{ student}\%) + (9 - 12 \text{ Total Points} * 9 - 12 \text{ student}\%) }{(K - 8 \text{ Total Points Eligible} * K - 8 \text{ student}\%) + (9 - 12 \text{ Total Points Eligible} * 9 - 12 \text{ student}\%)} \right)}{\left(\frac{(K - 8 \text{ Bonus Points} * K - 8 \text{ student}\%) + (9 - 12 \text{ Bonus Points} * 9 - 12 \text{ student}\%) }{(K - 8 \text{ Bonus Points Eligible} * K - 8 \text{ student}\%) + (9 - 12 \text{ Bonus Points Eligible} * 9 - 12 \text{ student}\%)} \right)}$$

Non-Typical schools are assigned an A-F Letter Grade using the Traditional 9-12 cut scores (below).
