School Safety Tipline Grant

- One-time appropriation of \$150,000 by the Arizona legislature for “electronic incident prevention system”
- Purpose is to maintain, purchase or develop a school safety tipline
- Application will be available in December via GME
- Awards will be made up to \$5000 and on a first come, first served basis



School Safety Program

- Additional \$50 million appropriated in June
- First made available to schools on the FY20 SRO waitlist
- Remainder will be made available in January 2023
- More information available in mid-November
