



Systems of early college career pathways that span grades 6-14+, enabling students to transition smoothly through high school, into higher education, and onto family-supporting careers—particularly in high-demand sectors like information technology, energy, healthcare, and advanced manufacturing









#### **1.** Expand and develop new solutions for career literacy and guidance
