

TRANSPORTATION

A.R.S. 15-2402 (B)(4)(o) | from the qualified student's residence and a qualified school in which the qualified student is enrolled

A.R.S. 15-2401(6)

6. "Qualified school" means a nongovernmental primary or secondary school or a preschool for pupils with disabilities that is located in this state or, for qualified students who reside within the boundaries of an Indian reservation in this state, that is located in an adjacent state and that is within two miles of the border of the state in which the qualified student resides, and that does not discriminate on the basis of race, color or national origin.

1. Transportation provided by private schools

Team will approve if the invoice has the following information:

- Student name
- Invoice/receipt can be for one student only (or list each student's cost separately)
- Private school name, or if a 3rd party transportation company, the vendor's name
- Transaction date or time period
- Total amount charged

2. Commuter Pass | Public Transportation (city bus and light rail passes)

Team will approve if the invoice has the following information:

- Invoice/receipt for one student pass only
- Vendor name
- Transaction date(s)
- Total amount charged

3. Transportation Network (Uber, Lyft, Taxi, etc.)

Team will approve if the invoice has the following information:

- Invoice/receipt for one ride only (listing student or parent name)
- Vendor name
- Transaction date
- Daytime hours only (no PM times)
- Total amount charged
- Invoice/receipt must have the student's physical address and the qualified school's address

IMPORTANT: Pursuant to state law, transportation costs related to field trips, out of state travel, provider/tutor appointments, gas, mileage, and other related vehicle costs are not approved expenses. Additionally, transportation to post-secondary institutions is disallowed.
