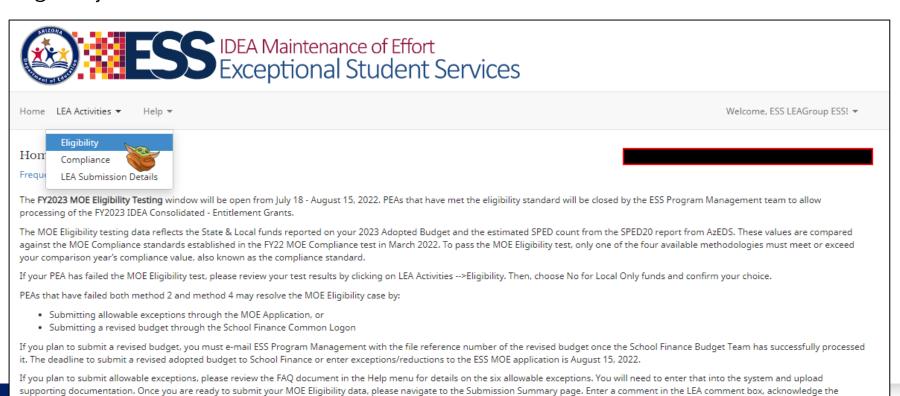

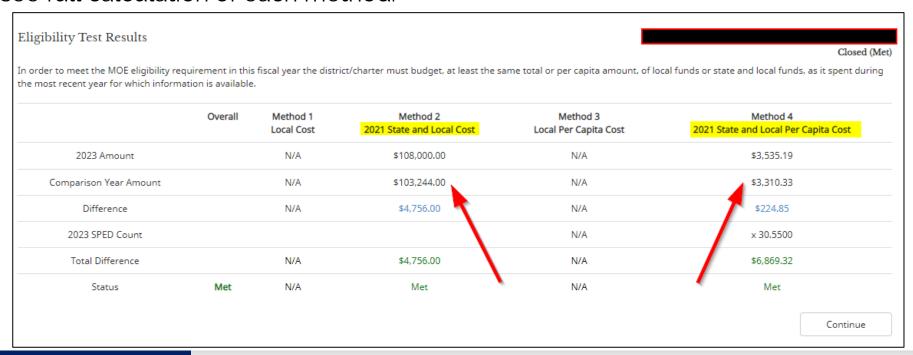

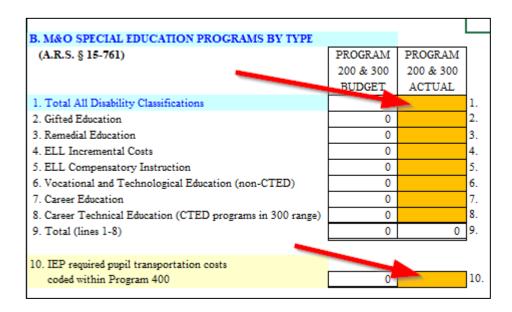
MOE ELIGIBILITY TEST RESULTS

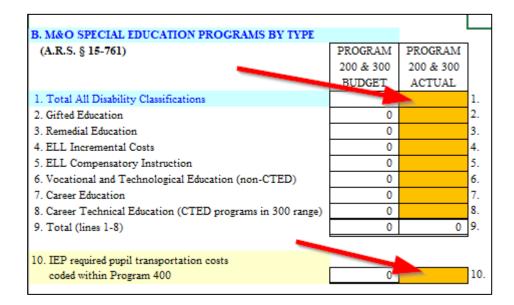

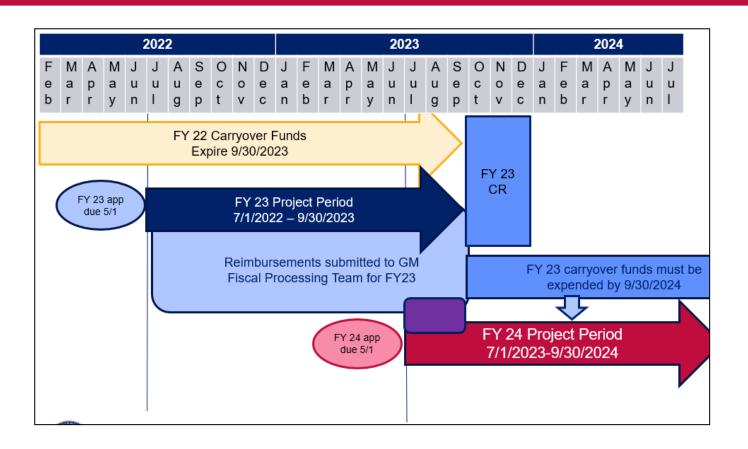

IDEA grant funds operate on a 15-month project period, with 12-month carryover, for a total of 27 months for obligation. IDEA grant funds must be liquidated (through the completion report process) 120 days after the expiration of the funds. If you have carryover of your 2022 IDEA grants, you must ensure that the carryover amount is fully drawn down by 9/30/2023 to prevent any funds from expiring and being returned to the federal government.
