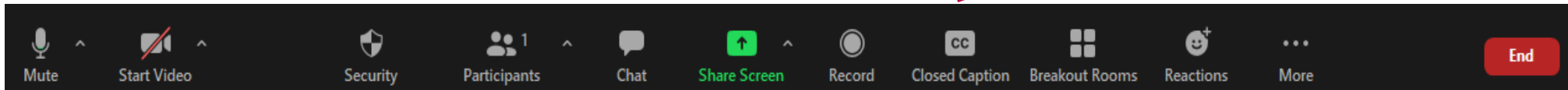

## October Data Collection Reconciliation Phase II

- Due Wednesday, January 18 by 5:00pm
  - Not just for special education count
  - Impacts other federal reporting areas
- Integrity Errors
  - FED SPED, Membership, and Accountability rules
- PEA Determinations
  - Valid and Timely Data

# Trending Topics

## Home-based vs. Homeschooled vs. Homebound

- How to report?
- Example:
  - Johnny is **homebound but** is also SPED. **Homebound** is an enrollment condition, which does not define the student as SPED.
  - If Johnny is **homeschooled** due to parental decision and is receiving services from the district on an ISP, then the student is **homeschooled (LRE J)**.
  - If Johnny is placed in the home per the IEP, this is called **home placement (LRE H)**.

PS	PH1	<b>Home AT LEAST 360 minutes per week.</b> Receives all special education and related services in the principal residence of the child's family or caregiver and attended neither a regular early childhood program nor a special education program provided in a separate class, separate school, or residential facility. Include children who receive special education both at the home and in a service provider location or some other location that is not in any other category. The term caregiver includes babysitters. The school of attendance would be the public school that they would typically attend if they were enrolled through the district.	Yes	Yes	R
PS	PH2	<b>Home LESS THAN 360 minutes per week.</b> Receives all special education and related services in the principal residence of the child's family or caregiver and attended neither a regular early childhood program nor a special education program provided in a separate class, separate school, or residential facility. Include children who received special education both at the home and in a service provider location or some other location that is not in any other category. The term caregiver includes babysitters. The school of attendance would be the public school that they would typically attend if they were enrolled through the district.	No	Yes	R

PS	PA2	<b>Attending Regular Early Childhood Program AT LEAST 10 hours per week; receiving majority of special education and related services in SOME OTHER LOCATION.</b> A program that includes at least 50% nondisabled children. This may include, but is not limited to: Head Start, kindergarten; preschool classes offered to an eligible pre-kindergarten population by the public school system; private kindergarten <sup>3</sup> or preschool; group child development center or child care.	Yes	Yes	R
PS	PB2	<b>Attending Regular Early Childhood Program LESS THAN 10 hours per week; receiving majority of special education and related services in SOME OTHER LOCATION.</b> A program that includes at least 50% nondisabled children. This may include, but is not limited to: Head Start, kindergarten; preschool classes offered to an eligible pre-kindergarten population by the public school system; private kindergarten <sup>3</sup> or preschool; group child development center or child care.	Yes	Yes	R

### SPED Reports 101

**What report should I use?**

With all the ADE reports available, you may be asking yourself this often when working on ESS Data Management requirements. This document provides a description of the reports related to Special Education to help determine when to use them and where they are located.

**ADEConnect Portal**

**AzEDS Portal** **ESS October 1** **ESS Special Education Data Dashboard**

**AzEDS Portal**

**SPED10** - SPED Data Verification Report - Verify raw data uploaded to AzEDS, **pre-integrity**. Updated: Up to 1 hour after your Student Information System syncs with AzEDS.

**SPED11** - Preschool Outcomes Report - Verify raw data for preschool outcomes uploaded to AzEDS, **pre-integrity**.

**SPED50** - SPED Concurrency Report - Shows only concurrently reported SPED Primary LRE Entry and Exit Dates reported by another PEA to aid collaboration in correcting the concurrency. Updated: Daily after integrity processing.

**SPED72** - SPED Participation Report filtered by DOA or DOR - View student's SPED need(s) and Least Restrictive Environment (LRE), **post-integrity**. Details if student is passing/failing SPED/Fed SPED Integrity. Updated: Daily after integrity processing.

**SPED73** - October 1 FED SPED Report filtered by DOA or DOR - Verify SPED students served on October 1 for Census. Students are categorized in three sections: Included in October 1 count, excluded due to failing FED SPED and/or Membership integrity, and unknown error pool. Updated: Daily after integrity processing.

**SPED74** - The SPED Exit Report shows student exit data to determine valid exits for the Special Education Data Dashboard (SEDD). Data within the report is by District of Residence only and displays students ages 13-22 based on Calculated Age for Exit. This report will outline each condition to be a valid exit for SEDD and provide feedback for any condition not met. Updated: Daily after integrity processing.

**SPED99** - The Orphan Data Report shows SPED records reported to AzEDS that are not associated

## SPED Reports 101

<u>AzEDS SPED Report</u>	<u>Use</u>
SPED10 – SPED Data Verification Report	Use after SIS sync to verify raw SPED data is landing in AzEDS the way you'd expect. (Pre-Integrity)
SPED11 – Preschool Outcomes Report	Use after SIS sync to verify raw Preschool Outcomes data is landing in AzEDS the way you'd expect. (Pre-Integrity)
SPED50 – SPED Concurrency Report	Shows Primary LREs that are reported at the same time. This includes if it's by the same PEA or a different PEA.
SPED72 – SPED Participation Report	Filter by DOA or DOR, View Student's SPED Need and LRE and if student is passing integrity. (Post-Integrity)
SPED73 – October 1 FED SPED Report	Filter by DOA or DOR, Verify SPED students served on October 1 for Oct 1 Count, or why the student is not counted. (Post-Integrity)
SPED74 – SPED Exit Report	Shows valid exit data for SPED students used for the Special Education Data Dashboard. Includes what conditions the student may/may not meet to qualify.
SPED99 – Orphan Data Report	Shows students reported with SPED Need or LRE but not associated with an enrollment. Orphan data does not show on other reports but can cause integrity failures.
<u>October 1 Data Collection Application</u>	<u>Use</u>
SPED07 – SPED students served over October 1.	Report is used for Phase II – Reconciliation. This report is a consolidation of students marked 'Y' for Oct 1 on the SPED73 report.

# Top 3 Integrity Errors

# Top 3 Integrity Errors

## Integrity Error -40062

- Error Message:
  - For each day there is a Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) provided, a SPED need must be reported.
- Common Issue At This Time:
  - Need Exit Date reported and LRE Exit Date is not.
  - Need was deleted but LRE remains.
- Possible Solution:
  - Review SPED10 Report.
    - Validate Exit Dates
    - Ensure at least two records are present for a SPED Student (LRE and Need)

# Top 3 Integrity Errors

## Integrity Error -40078

- Error Message:
  - Exit code SPED05 is invalid with continuing site enrollment..
- Common Issue At This Time:
  - LRE Changes mid-year.
  - LRE Exits and Begins again after weekend or fall break.
- Possible Solution:
  - Review guidance document [AzEDS Process for SPED Exit Code 9.](#)
  - Review reported calendar for in-session dates.
    - SPED05 cannot be used if the student is reported SPED the next in-session date at that site.

# Top 3 Integrity Errors

## Integrity Error -40067

- Error Message:
  - Missing Main SPED school indicator.
- Common Issue At This Time:
  - One LRE record reported and is reported as Secondary.
- Possible Solution:
  - Review guidance document [SPED School Concurrency and Federal Primary Need Indicator](#).
  - Review SPED10 report for primary indicators on LRE.
    - Any date a student is SPED:
      - One LRE must be reported Primary
      - One Need within each LRE must be reported Primary
