RE: **FY23 College Credit by Examination Incentive Program (CCEIP) Payments**

Dear CCEIP Recipients,

ADE is writing to inform you that FY23 payments to LEAs will be disbursed by March 1st.

The FY23 CCEIP payments public file with data redacted to preserve student privacy, and the list of ABOR approved eligible exams and cut scores, is available now for review at www.azed.gov/advanced-placement/cceip/. LEAs and schools can also access detailed student-level College Board AP[®] exam data at: apcentral.collegeboard.org/scores

Payments for incentive bonus amounts have been made per ARS §15-206(C):

- Schools with **50% or greater poverty rate: \$450** per qualifying eligible exam
- Schools with **less than 50% poverty rate: \$300** per qualifying eligible exam

As a reminder, please note the following statutory language of ARS §15-249.06(D) regarding the distribution of CCEIP payments:

D. A school district or charter school that receives an incentive bonus pursuant to this section **shall distribute at least fifty percent of the bonus monies to the associated classroom teacher** for each student who passes a qualifying examination **and to other teachers of relevant subjects who instructed that student, including but not limited to teachers in the same department or subject matter that contributed to the student passing the examination, as identified by the school district governing board, the charter school governing body or the school principal**. Bonus monies awarded to a teacher pursuant to this subsection are in addition to any regular wage, compensation or other bonus the teacher receives or is scheduled to receive and **shall be provided to the teacher by the end of the school year or not later than thirty days after the end of the school year**. The **remainder of any bonus monies received** by a school district or charter school **shall be allocated by the school principal** on behalf of students who receive a passing score and **may be used for teacher professional development or student instructional support, reimbursement of examination fees or instructional materials**. Any bonus monies received by a school district or charter school pursuant to this subsection shall be separately accounted for in the school district's or charter school's annual financial report.
