Initial Preschool Development Grant (PDG)

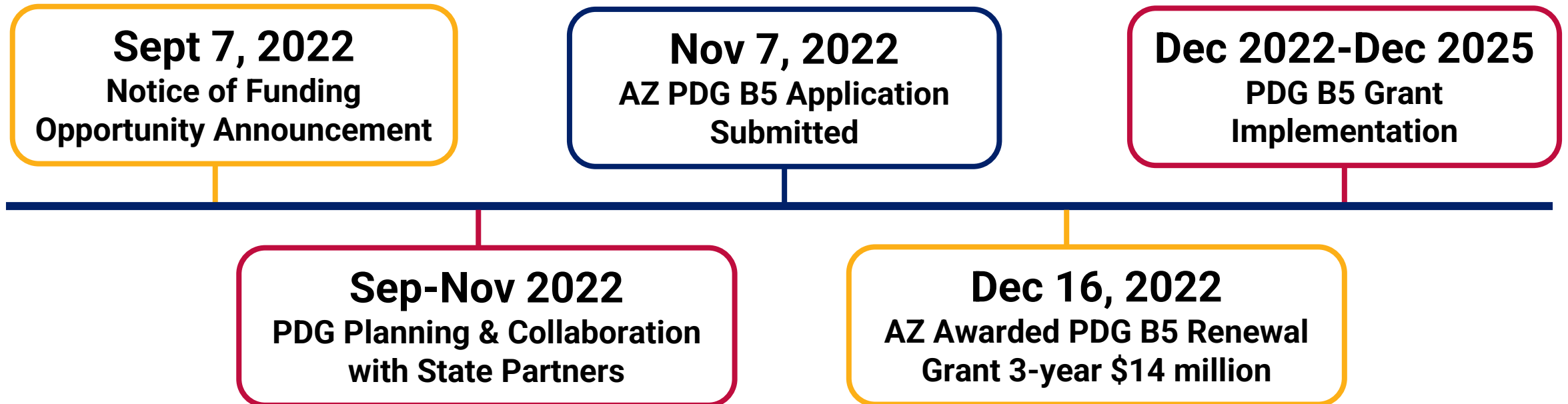
- ❑ ADE Submitted Application Oct 2014**
- ❑ AZ Awarded 4-year Grant Cycle 2015-2019**
 - Plus limited no cost extension in 2020
- ❑ Increased Preschool Slots**
 - 4-year-old children in high needs communities
 - Subgrant awards competitive application each year
- ❑ Improved Quality in Participating Programs**
 - Quality First Participation
 - Early Childhood Quality Improvement Process (ECQUIP)
 - Data Integration
 - Systems Building

Preschool Development Grant B5 Renewal (2022)

- ❑ Arizona 1 of 25 states eligible to apply
- ❑ Notice of Funding Opportunity Announcement: September 7, 2022
- ❑ PDG B5 Collaboration & Planning: Sept-Nov 2022
- ❑ Application Submitted: Nov 7, 2022
- ❑ Arizona Awarded \$14 million 3-year Grant: Dec 31, 2022
- ❑ Grant Cycle/Implementation: Jan 2023-Dec 2025

Maximize Parent and Family Engagement

❑ *Activity Three*

✓ **Maximize Parent and Family Engagement in B-5 System**

- **Statewide Activities**

- Enhance Arizona's Statewide Family Engagement Center (SFEC) and resources
- Family Engagement Learning cohorts
- Designate Parent-majority special advisory committee to inform needs assessment

- **Local Community Activities**

- Establish additional Regional Family Engagement Hubs
- Provide training and direct programming services to families

✓ **Support the B-5 Workforce and Disseminate Best Practices**

- **Professional Development**

- Increase trainings across B-5 system
- Enhance Workforce Registry

- **Recruitment & Retention**

- Hire Workforce Liaison
- Scholarships through AZ Teacher Academy
- Promote Experienced Educator Rule to increase certified ECE teachers in field
- Extend DES-DCC Professional Career Pathway Project (PCPP)
- Support Career & Technical Education (CTE) Early Childhood Programs

Subgrants to Enhance & Expand Access



❑ *Activity Six*

✓ **Subgrants to Enhance Quality and Expand Access to Existing and New Programs**

• **Infant-Toddler Startup/Expansion**

- \$5 million set aside for infant-toddler startup/expansion (high needs communities)
- Years 1-2 of PDG B5 (2023-2024)
- Cost will include furniture, materials, licensing fees, insurance, etc. to open infant-toddler classrooms
- Patterned after Early Head Start-Child Care Partnerships



High Quality Early Learning (HQEL) sites may apply based on eligibility

Subgrants to Enhance & Expand Access



❑ *Activity Six*

✓ **Subgrants to Enhance Quality and Expand Access to Existing and New Programs**

• **Birth-5 Subgrants for Slots**

- \$19 million will be awarded for subgrant sites (high needs communities)
- Subgrants awarded per child (infants, toddlers, and preschool age children)
- Priority given to programs serving infants/toddlers
- Eligible to programs receiving startup/expansion funds
- Approximately 1,000 children in estimated 50 sites will be awarded



High Quality Early Learning (HQEL) sites may apply based on eligibility

Subgrants to Enhance & Expand Access

❑ *Activity Six*

- ✓ **Subgrants to Enhance Quality and Expand Access to Existing and New Programs**

Age Group	Estimated Monthly Cost per Enrolled Child	Estimated Annual Cost per Enrolled Child
Infant (0-12 months)	\$2,277	\$27,324
Toddler (1-3 years)	\$1,400	\$16,800
Preschool (3-5 years)	\$1,147	\$13,764



Increasing Access to Inclusive Settings

❑ *Bonus Area*

✓ **Increasing Access to Inclusive Settings**

- **Increase % of Children in Inclusive Settings**
 - Goal: 50% (Current: 31%)
- **ECE Inclusion Specialist**
 - ADE ECE team will hire Inclusion Specialist
- **Professional Development**
 - Increase trainings for Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE) available in Workforce Registry
 - Provide TA & Training on Itinerant Model and Inclusive Classroom Profile (ICP)



❑ *Bonus Area*

✓ **Improving Workforce Compensation**

- **Workforce Wage Enhancement**

- Subgrantees will participate in Workforce Compensation Pilot
- Ensure ECE staff are compensated based on the AZ Educator Salary Scale

- **Blending & Braiding ECE Funding**

- Provide training and resources to support ECE program funding utilizing multiple sources
- Update ECE Funding Manual

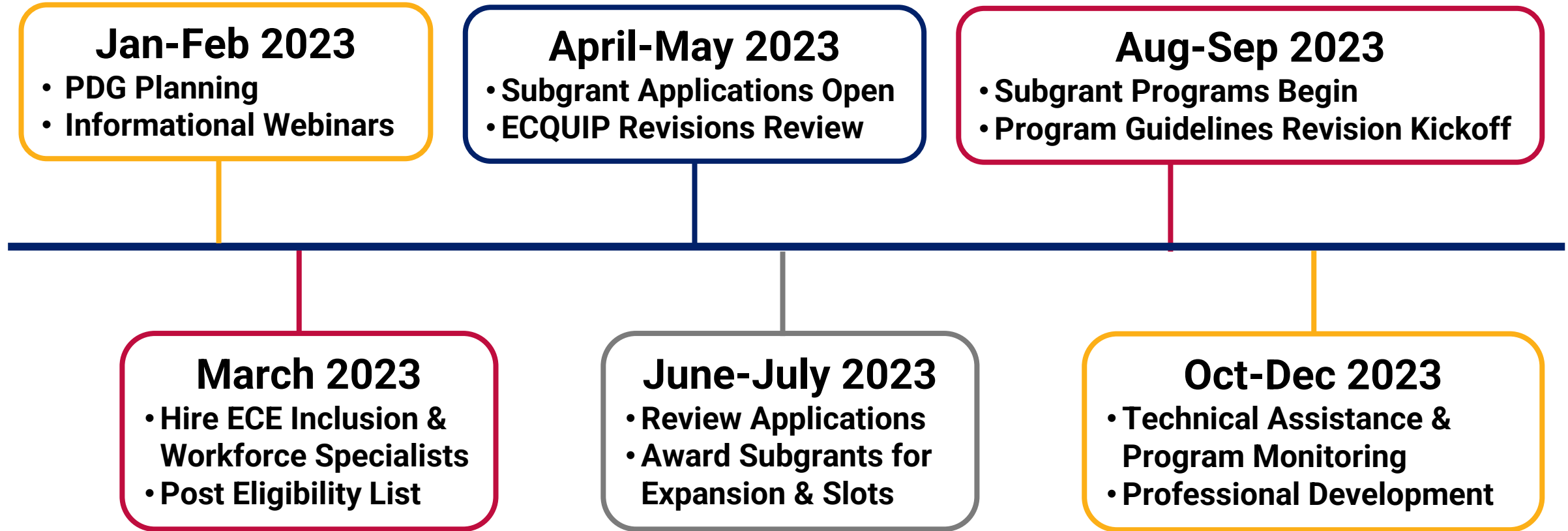
