

Who Can Offer a DRP?

- Every school district or charter district that provides instruction to high school students can offer a Dropout Recovery Program (DRP) for eligible pupils.
- School operating DRP must be an approved alternative school.
 - A provider of Arizona Online Instruction (AOI), may **not** also operate a DRP, according to A.R.S. §15-808
- School and charter districts may contract with an Educational Management Organization (EMO) to provide a DRP.
 - If contracting with an EMO, the LEA shall ensure that all of the following requirements are met:
 - The EMO is accredited by a regional accrediting body.
 - Teachers provided by the EMO hold a current teaching license from any state and a valid Arizona fingerprint clearance card according to section A.R.S. §15-534. Teachers of core subjects are appropriately certified in the subjects they are assigned.
