

New CTE Teacher PD for Certification Credit

The following courses are available to new CTE teachers to help satisfy the deficiencies listed on the Arizona Educator Certificate. Professional organizations, postsecondary institutions, CTEDS, and districts can apply with ADE CTE to offer semester-hour accredited Professional Development (PD).

15 semester hours may be obtained through Arizona State Board-approved CTE PD to clear certificate deficiencies for application option A and C teachers. Option B teachers can earn certification credit towards their application requirements in CTE-approved areas 1-3 and are indicated below*.

CTE Approved PD Areas:

- 1- Principles/philosophy of career and technical education*
- 2- Developmentally (age) appropriate instructional delivery, facilitation, and methodologies*
- 3- Instructional technology*
- 4- Instructional design, and lesson planning to include modifications and accommodations, assessing, monitoring, and reporting progress
- 5- The learning environment to include classroom management
- 6- Teaching students with exceptionalities
- 7- Professional responsibility and ethical conduct
