# **SEI BUDGET TIMELINE**

### March 1 - May 2

LEA window to apply is open. LEAs missing the May deadline will not be considered for funding.



Review and approval phase of applications received by May 2. Amount requested may need to be adjusted by LEA. ADE will communicate this, if needed.



Targeted application approval date. Applications in SEA Director Approved status can begin to draw down funds.



June 30 (12 month grant)

Project closes.

- Reimbursement Request Deadline: All Reimbursement Requests must be submitted and approved PRIOR to the project end date. Reimbursement deadlines will be set, as applicable, based on ADE/ADOA Accounting requirements for fiscal year and/or project end dates

Questions regarding dates and deadlines (with the exception of reimbursement requests deadlines) should be directed to the Office of English Language Acquisition Services (OELAS) or your Title III Program Specialist.

### STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Submitted costs must be compliant with the "cost efficient" requirement of the "SEI" models stated in 15-756.01 (B).
- 2. 15-756.01 F The state board of education shall establish procedures for school districts and charter schools to determine the incremental costs for implementation of the research-based models of structured English immersion developed by the state board of education.
- 15-756.01 J 2: "Incremental Costs" means costs that are associated with a structured English immersion program pursuant to section 15-752 or a program pursuant to section 15-753 and that are in addition to the normal costs of conducting programs for English proficient students. Incremental costs do not include costs that replace the same types of services provided to English proficient students or compensatory instruction.

### DEFINITIONS

### Incremental Teacher Salaries

Incremental teachers are teachers that are in addition to the normal costs of conducting programs for English proficient students as required to meet the state board of education approved model requirements, as per ARS §15-756.01.

Note: The SEI Budget-Comprehensive Funding Application uses statewide data obtained from ADE School Finance to determine the average teacher salary amount.

### Incremental Teacher Benefits

Benefits for the incremental teachers may include Retirement, Social Security Contributions, Unemployment Insurance, Workers' Compensation and health care coverage

Note: The SEI Budget-Comprehensive Funding Application auto-calculates the benefits cost at 25% of the salary amount.

3.	Complete the Budget section of the application to allocate funding for incremental salaries (6100/1000) and associated benefits (6200/1000).								

### INCREMENTAL TEACHER SPREADSHEET

The bulk of the data on this page pre-populates based on the individual school site and grade level requesting incremental teacher salaries. (See DEFINITIONS on the Program Information / Instructions page of this Funding Application)

- 1. Select appropriate FTE amount/amounts (in increments of .25 FTE) for incremental costs being requested. Keep in mind the FTE or portion of FTE being requested should correspond to the number of targeted instructional ELD minutes per day assigned to the teacher(s) you are requesting.
- Select the appropriate SEI Model for each specific grade level requesting an FTE.
- 3. In the Incremental Staff Justification textbox, enter a brief narrative which justifies the requested funding and how it is incremental. Include the number of required targeted instructional ELD minutes per day assigned to the teacher(s), grade level groupings, etc.
- 4. The Funding Application will auto-calculate the salary and benefit amount based on the entered FTE.
- 5. OELAS reviews all FTE requests in relation to EL student counts, grade level bands. SEI Model selected and average class size to determine the eligible FTE amount.
- 6. Submission of this Funding Application does not guarantee award of SEI Budget funds.

As information is entered into the Incremental Teacher Spreadsheet, the Funding Application will auto-calculate the cumulative total for incremental costs of the models as requested by the LEA. This total will also populate in the table on the LEA Offsets Worksheet page.

### LEA OFFSETS WORKSHEET

All Arizona LEAs receive weighted state funding, EL Group B Weight, for ELs enrolled in their schools. Some Arizona LEAs also receive Desegregation funds to support this subgroup of students. These funding amounts, obtained from ADE School Finance, can be found on the LEA Offsets Worksheet page of this Funding Application.

Because LEAs already receive funding to support EL students, dollars received from these two funding sources mentioned above will offset the amount of funding an LEA is eligible to receive from the SEI Budget fund. The Budget Request Worksheet table on the LEA Offsets Worksheet page provides the following information:

Total Incremental Costs of the Models - this is the sum of all salary and benefits requested by the LEA on the Incremental Teacher Spreadsheet

Total Offsets - this is the sum of EL Group B Weight funding + Deseg funds

Total Approvable Budget Request - this is the maximum amount of funding an LEA could receive

Requested SEI Budget-Comprehensive salary and benefits amounts will be reduced by Group B Weight and the EL percentage of any Desegregation funding the LEA receives to determine the Total Approvable Budget Request amount.

Once the submission window for the SEI Budget-Comprehensive application closes, all applications are reviewed for approval based on information provided by each LEA at the time of submission. Applications are not accepted after the submission window has closed and appeals are not considered.

The OELAS Grants Team reviews all requests and determines the FTE amount eligible to be funded. The Arizona Department of Education receives a pre-determined SEI Budget award amount from the State Legislature. In the event the total amount of all approvable applications exceeds this award amount all LEAs receive a proportionate share of the total.


