



AVAILABILITY OF LOCAL REPORT

Each eligible subrecipient that receives an allocation described in section 112 of the Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act (“Perkins V”) must make available a local report that includes actual levels of performance for each of the indicators of performance specified in that Act. The Arizona Department of Education prepares a report for eligible subrecipients that meets the minimum requirements; eligible recipients must make this report or a similar report that contains identical data available through a variety of formats, including electronically through the Internet, to students, parents, educators, and the public and the information contained in such a report shall be in a format that is understandable and uniform, and to the extent practicable, provided in a language that students, parents, and educators can understand.

SEC. 112 [20 U.S.C. 2322] WITHIN STATE ALLOCATION

Section 112 of Perkins V determines within-state allocations for the following:

- Secondary education programs
- Postsecondary education programs
- State institutions, such as state correctional institutions, juvenile justice facilities, and educational institutions that serve individuals with disabilities
