Performance Standard 2: Meal Components & Quantities - Critical Area

1 Quantities observed during the review period did not meet minimum amounts required by the meal pattern for Grades 9-12. Specifically, 1 banana was credited as 1 cup instead of 1/2 cup, which resulted in not meeting minimum requirements for fruit on 12/15/2022 for Grades 9-12.
