

**Facilitate** an understanding of the Arizona Department of Education as a service organization committed to raising academic outcomes for Native American students




Provide direct avenues of **communication** that support continuous stakeholder input and feedback



Create and maintain **relationships** between ADE and Indigenous communities to drive positive change for Native American students







## Raising Indigenous Success in Education (RISE) Grant

- 3-year grant opportunity
- Seeks to support **educational needs** and **opportunities** in Arizona districts and schools that serve a significant number of Native American students and staff
- Align with the Office of Indian Education legislation A.R.S. 15-244



## Eligible Entities

- Districts in Arizona serving Native American students and educators, including
  - Public Schools
  - Charter Schools
  - Consortiums consisting of tribally-controlled and/or grant schools

- Open: March 1, 2023
- Close: May 1, 2023

### Project Timeline

- Start: July 1, 2023
- End: June 30, 2024
