



PERKINS V PERFORMANCE MEASURES

The State of Arizona met all three postsecondary Perkins V performance measures for FY 2021-2022.

FY 2022 – 2023 PERKINS V DATA REPORTING

The Postsecondary Perkins V Consolidated Annual Report (CAR III Enrollment and CAR IV Performance) pages will open in the CTE Data Portal website this Fall (typically in October) and will remain open for reporting through late December.

Submitting the CAR III and IV requires access to the CTE Data Portal web application. Please ensure that you or the appropriate designee has access to the CTE Data Portal via ADEConnect.

PERFORMANCE MEASURE REPORT AVAILABILITY

Each eligible subrecipient, including postsecondary institutions, that receives an allocation described in section 112 of the Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act (“Perkins V”) must make available a local report that includes actual levels of performance for each of the indicators of performance specified in that Act.
