## PERKINS V PERFORMANCE MEASURES

The State of Arizona met all three postsecondary Perkins V performance measures for FY 2021-2022.

Measure	Numerator	Denominator	Actual Level of Performance	Target Level of Performance
1P1 Placement	6463	12581	51.37%	35.5%
2P1 Credentials	12994	26688	48.69%	45.5%
3P1 Nontraditional	9331	30365	30.73%	22.5%

Three postsecondary institutions that did not meet at least 90% of the target level of performance for one or more Perkins V performance measure will submit or have submitted performance improvement plans as part of their CTE Postsecondary Federal Perkins grant application. The Postsecondary Perkins V Consolidated Annual Report (CAR III Enrollment and CAR IV Performance) pages will open in the CTE Data Portal website this Fall (typically in October) and will remain open for reporting through late December. Dates will be determined, and a notice sent to all postsecondary recipients towards the end of this Summer. ## PERFORMANCE MEASURE REPORT AVAILABILITY

Each eligible subrecipient, including postsecondary institutions, that receives an allocation described in section 112 of the Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act ("Perkins V") must make available a local report that includes actual levels of performance for each of the indicators of performance specified in that Act. The local report must contain the sub-recipient's performance data and must be available in a variety of formats, including electronically through the Internet, to students, parents, educators, and the public and the information contained in such a report shall be in a format that is understandable and uniform, and to the extent practicable, provided in a language that students, parents, and educators can understand.
