Considerations for SEI Model Selection:

- What is your **mission and vision** for ELs in your district/school/charter?
- What are the **grade levels** with ELs?
- What are the **English proficiency levels** of your students?
- Are the ELs who are the least proficient in English provided more **intensive instruction**?
- Is more than one model needed?
- Does your LEA have qualified staff to implement the SEI Model?
- What **classroom space** is available to provide Targeted Instruction?
- Are ELs provided the opportunity to participate meaningfully and equally in all the schools' programs?

Guidance for Grouping for Targeted Instruction:

Classes should be comprised of ELs in only one grade level and English proficiency level to the *extent possible*. When lower numbers indicate a need, student groups may contain students within two adjacent proficiency levels and/or in more than one grade level within the same ELP Standards band.
