Initial Preschool Development Grant (PDG)

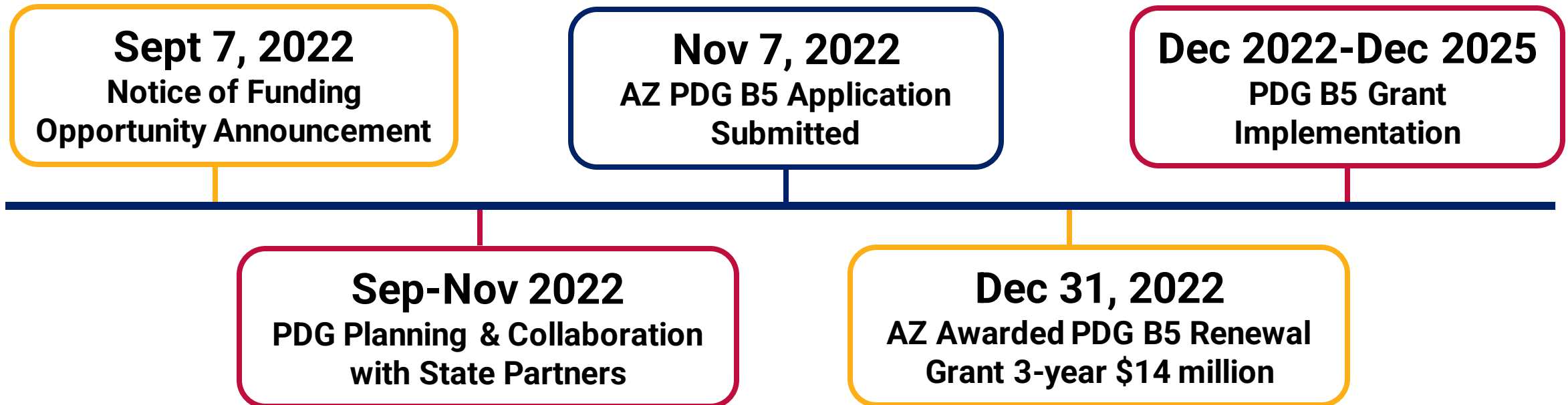
- ❑ ADE Submitted Application Oct 2014**
- ❑ AZ Awarded 4-year Grant Cycle 2015-2019**
 - Plus limited no cost extension in 2020
- ❑ Increased Preschool Slots**
 - 4-year-old children in high needs communities
 - Subgrant awards competitive application each year
- ❑ Improved Quality in Participating Programs**
 - Quality First Participation
 - Early Childhood Quality Improvement Process (ECQUIP)
 - Data Integration
 - Systems Building

Preschool Development Grant B5 Renewal (2022)

- ❑ Arizona 1 of 25 states eligible to apply
- ❑ Notice of Funding Opportunity Announcement: September 7, 2022
- ❑ PDG B5 Collaboration & Planning: Sept-Nov 2022
- ❑ Application Submitted: Nov 7, 2022
- ❑ Arizona Awarded \$14 million 3-year Grant: Dec 31, 2022
- ❑ Grant Cycle/Implementation: Jan 2023-Dec 2025

Subgrants to Enhance & Expand Access

❑ *Activity Six*

✓ **Subgrants to Enhance Quality and Expand Access to Existing and New Programs**

• **Infant-Toddler Startup/Expansion**

- **\$5 million for infant-toddler startup/expansion in high needs communities**
- **Years 1-2 of PDG B5 (2023-2024)**
- **Allowable costs include furniture, materials, staffing, etc. for infant-toddler classrooms**
- **Classrooms must be established on a licensed site (*construction not allowed*)**
- **Approximately 24 sites total (12 per year)**



Subgrants to Enhance & Expand Access



❑ *Activity Six*

✓ **Subgrants to Enhance Quality and Expand Access to Existing and New Programs**

• **Birth-5 Subgrants for Slots**

- **\$19 million will be awarded for subgrant sites in high needs communities across three years**
- **Subgrants awarded per child (*infants, toddlers, and preschool age children*)**
- **Priority given to programs serving infants/toddlers**
- **Eligible for programs receiving startup/expansion funds**
- **Approximately 640 children in estimated 55 sites will be awarded through life of the grant**



Increasing Access to Inclusive Settings

❑ *Bonus Area*

✓ **Increasing Access to Inclusive Settings**

- **Increase % of Children in Inclusive Settings**
 - **Goal: 50% (Current: 31%)**
- **ECE Inclusion Specialist**
 - **ADE ECE team will hire Inclusion Specialist**
- **Professional Development**
 - **Increase trainings for Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE) available in Workforce Registry**
 - **Provide TA & Training on Itinerant Model and Pyramid Model**



❑ *Bonus Area*

✓ **Improving Workforce Compensation**

- **Workforce Wage Enhancement**

- Subgrantees will participate in Workforce Compensation Pilot
- Ensure ECE staff in subgrant awarded sites are compensated based on the AZ Educator Salary Scale (DES DCC)

- **Blending & Braiding ECE Funding**

- Provide training and resources to support ECE program funding utilizing multiple sources
- Update ECE Funding Manual

| Infant & Toddler Startup / Expansion | Awarded Amount for Startup/Expansion |
|--------------------------------------|--------------------------------------|
| Max Awarded Amount per Site | \$200,000 |
| Estimated Number of Sites Awarded | 12 sites (per cohort) |

** Eligible sites may apply for a maximum of \$200,000 for startup/expansion.*

| Age Group | Estimated Monthly Amount per Enrolled Child | Annual Award Amount per Enrolled Child | Estimated total Slots to be Awarded (Cohort 1) |
|-----------------------|---|--|--|
| Infant (0-12 months) | \$1,833 | \$22,000 | 54 |
| Toddler (1-3 years) | \$1,333 | \$16,000 | 74 |
| Preschool (3-5 years) | \$1,000 | \$12,000 | 298 |

Subgrants to Enhance & Expand Access

| Age Group | Max Number of Slots |

| Subgrant Application Options | Age Group | Max Award Amount |
|----------------------------------|------------------------------------|------------------|
| Startup/Expansion Only | Infants & Toddlers | \$200,000 |
| Slot Funding Only | Max 10 slots across all age groups | \$220,000 |
| Startup/Expansion & Slot Funding | Startup <i>plus</i> max 10 slots | \$420,000 |

** Eligible sites may apply for a maximum of \$420,000 for both startup/expansion & slots or \$240,000 for slot funding only*

PDG B5 Subgrant Eligibility- Unique Entity Identifier



Step 1: SAM.gov. Registration/Renewal

Your organization must have an active SAM.gov registration prior to submitting a Preschool Development Grant B-5 (PDG B-5) application. Upon successful completion of a SAM.gov registration, a **Unique Entity Identifier (UEI)**, formerly DUNS, number will be issued to your organization.

The SAM.gov UEI registration process can take up to 10 business days to complete.

Complete a System for Award Management (SAM) registration as a business for federal contracting or grants, or nonprofit entity for grants. Your SAM registration will be valid for one year from the date the registration is complete.



A SAM registration must be renewed each year to remain active and compliant. USFCR recommends renewing 90 days prior to the SAM expiration date. If you are renewing an existing SAM registration, please [click here](#).

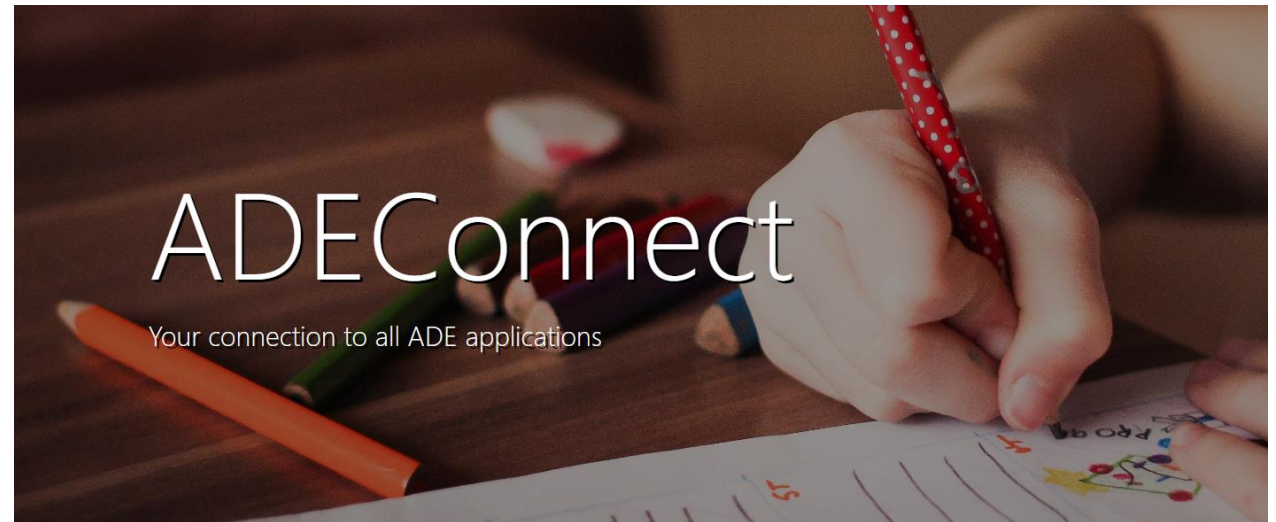

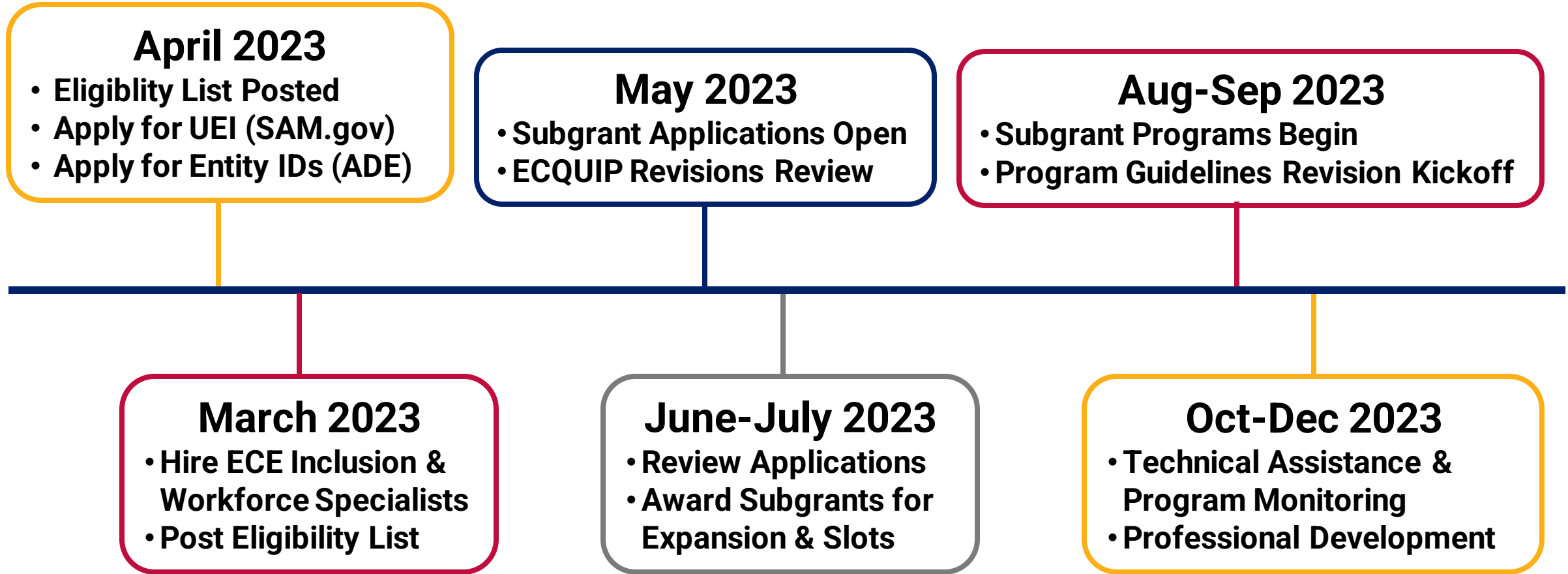
