# 2023-2024 Chapter Officer Leadership Training Series



Advisors wishing for their students to attend the Chapter Officer Leadership Training ("COLT") will need to complete the online registration form **AND** submit a medical consent/conduct agreement for each student (either digitally or at on site registration). The registration fee will cover the participant's dinner on Friday, breakfast on Saturday as well as hotel accommodations. Students will be assigned to rooms with other conference participants (of the same gender) as needed to conserve hotel costs. There are **no refunds** for non-attendance. A \$25.00 fee will be assessed to all checks returned "insufficient funds."

#### Who should attend?

Each chapter is encouraged to send their chapter officer team to participate in each COLT. **The entire chapter officer team is welcome and encouraged to attend!** It is up to each chapter advisor to determine who may attend. It is required that all attendees be enrolled in an approved Ag Ed Program and be in grades 9-12. No exceptions. Workshops at COLT are intended to help chapter officers/leaders prepare for "what's next" in their school year.

## Special Notes:

- The submission of the conference registration implies consent to using any photos/video footage taken at COLT, which may include you, on the website, in videos or in other publications produced by Arizona FFA. All necessary forms can also be found at azffa.org.
- Students staying the night will be roomed with up to 3 other students (same gender). Every effort will be made to keep chapters together (with respect to gender).
- Students should arrive at COLT on Friday already having eaten lunch. Registration occurs at the hotel.
- Students who live locally and wish to receive a discounted registration may choose not to stay at the hotel and travel home on Friday evening. Please come prepared with parental/guardian permission to drive home.

# **Arizona FFA Summit Conference Series Information Sheet**

#### What is the Summit Conference Series?

The Summit Conference Series is a traveling four part conference series with a conference designed for students in each grade level. The Embark (Greenhand), Elevate (Sophomore) and Ascend (Junior) Conferences are held in the fall and take place at 7 locations across the state.



Embark: A Greenhand Conference is designed to intrigue and excite the 8th and 9th grade FFA members about the organization. This conference is the "hook - line - and sinker" to get students to buy into the FFA organization throughout their four years in high school. The objectives of the conference are to share many of the benefits of FFA, increase knowledge of first year activities, develop agricultural career awareness, and design an individual personal plan of involvement to help guide the student through his/her first year of agriculture education enrollment.



**Elevate:** A Sophomore Leadership Conference will focus on a student's individual development with an emphasis on identifying their leadership qualities in an effort to better enable them to facilitate personal growth and set goals. Attendees will identify their personal leadership qualities as well as develop a plan for utilizing those qualities to become a contributing member of their FFA Chapter, school and community.



**Ascend:** A Junior Leadership Conference will focus on a student's interactions with others and will include relationship building, maintaining relationships, serving others and refilling their own personal cup. Attendees will develop a deep understanding of the factors that contribute to relationships, both positive and negative, and how to strengthen those relationships. They will dive into understanding the pressures of service in today's society and develop a plan to serve others using their time, talents and treasures.

# Who may attend?

The Embark: Greenhand Conference is open to 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grade students only. The Elevate: Sophomore Leadership Conference is open to 10<sup>th</sup> graders only. The Ascend: Junior Leadership Conference is open to 11<sup>th</sup> grade students only. Registration is on a first come, first serve basis. We reserve the right to cap registration per location if necessary. There is no limit to the number of students that a chapter may bring.

**Note:** No reimbursement of conference fees for non-attendance will be provided except for circumstances due to a disabling injury or illness, or death in the immediate family. Such cases require a written explanation by the advisor to be submitted to the State FFA Office for reimbursement.

# **Hotel Reservations**

Chapters are responsible for making appropriate hotel arrangements. In most cases, hotel rooms are not needed.

#### **Medical Consent Forms-Conduct Agreements**

**Each student** attending the conference must complete a Medical Consent-Conduct Agreement. These forms may be found at azffa.org, under the downloads tab, in the folder entitled "Medical Consent-Conduct Agreement" Completed forms must be in the presence of the advisor at the event. The Arizona Association FFA will purchase no additional accident insurance. Participants must be covered by individual and/or school insurance policies.

# **Special Needs**

Students needing special accommodations or special services should contact the State FFA Office at 602-542-5564 at least 14 days prior to the event. The needs of specialized services must be documented and verified by the school and district office. It is the responsibility of the school and district to provide assistance for the hearing impaired. We will do everything we can to accommodate all students to enhance learning experiences, but prior knowledge of special circumstances must be known in advance.

This year all chapters will **be booking their own hotel rooms** through Arizona's State Block link on the Indy Housing Bureau Website. In order to receive the housing link you will need to get this form completed and signed by an administrator. Once you upload the form the link will be sent to you via the email confirmation. You will need a valid credit card to book. This card will not be charged at the time of booking and can be changed out at any time through October 4. Arrangements to pay the final hotel bill by purchase order will be made directly with the hotel. **Payment will not be processed through Arizona FFA.** You will need your chapter number at booking to ensure you get the "in housing block" rate when you register for the Convention itself through National FFA.

All rooms are first come, first serve. Please be thoughtful, only reserve the rooms you need and maximize the space you reserve. **Any rooms you cancel will be assessed one night's room and tax per room cancelled!** We have two types of room in our block:

**Embassy Suites - King Suite** (one king bed and one pull out bed) – sleeps 4 - Rate \$205 1-2 people, \$212 3-4 people (plus tax)

Marriot - Two Queen Bed Room (2 queen beds) – sleeps 4 - Rate \$222 1-4 people (plus tax)
