

Eligibility Policy for Students to Take and Retake the Technical Skills Assessment (TSA)

Updated March 2024

- In a traditional or block schedule, a student should take the test when completing two
 courses for one credit each in a single CTE program or when completing three courses for
 one credit each in a single CTE program. A student can only take the test one time.
- 2. If a district adds a course(s) to a single program beyond the state's designated course sequence, it will be the district's decision as to when the student will take the test, i.e., after the second, third, or fourth course. A student can only take the test one time.
- 3. If a student fails the test, they can retake the test the next year prior to graduation if they take another course in the same program sequence or participate in a work-based learning opportunity such as an internship. Special arrangements must be made with ADE/CTE to make this request. <u>The last score counts.</u>
- 4. **If an IEP or 504 plan states that the student can take the test more than one time,** they can retake the test in the current or next school year prior to graduation through special arrangements with ADE/CTE. <u>The last score counts.</u>
