



Annually, the Arizona Department of Education (ADE) is required to report Special Education data to the federal government. The October 1 Data Collection is part of that process and occurs in three phases.

ESS Data Management FY 2024 Important Dates

Dates are subject to change at any time. Subscribe to the ESS DM Alerts for updates.

ESS OCTOBER 1 DATA COLLECTION (ODC)

- . Count Date: October 1, 2023 (*Not a Due Date)
- Open Date: October 2, 2023

PHASE I: PERSONNEL & VERIFICATION COUNT

- Verification Count, Personnel Data & Electronic Signature Due:
- November 15, 2023, by 5:00 pm
- Verification count and/or personnel data can be submitted/modified anytime between October 2 - November 15, 2023

PHASE II: RECONCILIATION

- Reconciliation Due: January 17, 2024, in AzEDS by 5:00 pm
- The SPED07 report will be available November 20, 2023, and the report will update daily after AzEDS integrity processing runs until the final reconciliation
- Continue checking the SPED07 report regularly during this time, even if your PEA's counts reconcile early in the process
- The preliminary final SPED07 report will be based on the data in AzEDS at the time of the reconciliation due date

PHASE III: NON-RECONCILIATION (IF APPLICABLE)

- Open Date: March 13, 2024
- Non-Reconciliation Due: April 24, 2024, by 5:00 pm
- PEAs that do not reconcile will be required to complete this phase, and ADEConnect users will be notified via email

- Start Early
- Check Reports Regularly
- ➤ Utilize ESS DM ODC Resources
- Solve Integrity Errors Quickly

- Open Date: May 8, 2024
- Exit Data Due: July 15, 2024, by 5:00 pm
- . Discipline Data Due: July 15, 2024, by 5:00 pm
- Preschool Transition Data Entry Opens: July 1, 2024
- Students Without Disabilities Data Entry Opens: July 1, 2024
- SEDD Data Certification Opens: July 22, 2024
- SEDD Data Certification Due: August 5, 2024, by 5:00 pm

SPED Reports 101

What report should I use?

With all the ADE reports available, you may be asking yourself this often when working on ESS Data Management requirements. This document provides a description of the reports related to Special Education to help determine when to use them and where they are located.

AzEDS Portal

- SPED10 SPED Data Verification Report Verify raw data uploaded to AzEDS, pre-integrity. Updated: Up to 1 hour after your Student Information System syncs with AzEDS.
- SPED11 Preschool Outcomes Report Verify raw data for preschool outcomes uploaded to AzEDS, pre-integrity.
- SPED50 SPED Concurrency Report Shows only concurrently reported SPED Primary LRE Entry and Exit Dates reported by another PEA to aid collaboration in correcting the concurrency. Updated: Daily after integrity processing.
- SPED72 SPED Participation Report filtered by DOA or DOR View student's SPED need(s) and Least Restrictive Environment (LRE), post-integrity. Details if student is passing/failing SPED/Fed SPED Integrity. Updated: Daily after integrity processing.
- SPED73 October 1 FED SPED Report filtered by DOA or DOR Verify SPED students served on October 1 for Census. Students are categorized in three sections: Included in October 1 count, excluded due to failing FED SPED and/or Membership Integrity, and unknown error pool. Updated: Daily after integrity processing.
- SPED74 The SPED Exit Report shows student exit data to determine valid exits for the Special Education Data Dashboard (SEDD). Data within the report is by District of Residence only and displays students ages 13-22 based on Calculated Age for Exit. This report will outline each condition to be a valid exit for SEDD and provide feedback for any condition not met. Updated: Daily after integrity processing.
- SPED99 The Orphan Data Report shows SPED records reported to AzEDS that are not associated with an enrollment. This commonly occurs when enrollments are deleted and SPED data remains, typically resulting in concurrency errors. Updated: Daily after integrity processing.

ADEConnect role needed to request access to these reports: AzEDS Data Coordinator - SPED Reports.

October 1 Data Collection (ODC)

 Federal requirement under Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) Section 618.

- Includes:
 - Child Count Verification
 - Personnel
 - Electronic signature required
 - Data is reported to the Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP)



October 1 Child Count Verification Count

 Used to verify the unduplicated count of students receiving special education and related services on October 1 (ages 3-21)

Used to determine base funding for all PEAs in Federal

Part B allocations



October 1 Data Collection - Phases

Phase I

- SPED child verification count
- Personnel
- Electronic Signature
- Due in the ODC application
- Child verification count can no longer be changed

Phase II

- Reconciliation begins
- SPED07 report available
- SPED data due in AzEDS
- Reconciliation due (SPED07 count must align with child verification count)
- SPED07 report will not update after due date
- ADE submits data to OSEP

Phase III

- Non-Reconciliation begins
- Provide a reason as to why the SPED07 count did not align with the Child Verification count
- Submission due in the ODC application



October 1 Data Collection – Personnel

- Fully certified or not
- Providing SPED/related services
- Full-Time Equivalency (FTE)
- Three Sections:
 - Teachers
 - Paraprofessionals
 - Related service providers






October 1 Data Collection – Strategies

Verification Count

- Start early and get your team involved
- Save all documentation
- Develop a plan to avoid non-reconciliation
- Check reports regularly

Personnel

- Work with Human Resources
- Double-check FTE calculations

Discipline Data Collection (DDC)

Discipline Data Collection – Overview

- Disciplinary incident data for students with disabilities
 - Ages 3 21 as of October 1
 - Reporting year is from July 1 June 30
- Student Information Systems (SIS) > AzEDS
 - AzEDS is the source of truth
- Data must be submitted by July 15, 2024



 - Display Only
- Discipline Data AzEDS Reports
 - ADEConnect Role:
 - AzEDS Data Coordinator (Discipline Reports)



Data Collection Strategies

- Validate your data is uploading correctly to AzEDS
 - DISC10 Discipline Data Verification Report
 - Collaborate with your vendor if having issues
- Incident information is passing integrity
 - DISC72 Discipline Validation Report
 - INTEG55 Discipline Incident Integrity Report
- Make necessary changes and upload the data in AzEDS by the due date
