Summary of Webinar 1

Purpose of OIE RISE Funds	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Support educational needs and opportunities in Arizona districts and schools that serve a significant number of Native American students and staff, consistent with the purposes of the Office of Indian Education legislation A.R.S. 15-244.
Eligible Applicants	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• LEAs, Charters, Tribally-controlled, Grant, and BIE-funded schools
Eligibility Requirement	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Must serve Native American students and educators in K-12 contexts
Grant Application Open Date	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• March 1, 2023
Grant Application Close Date	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• May 1, 2023
Project Period for FY24	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024
Grant Cycle Availability	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• July 1, 2023 – September 30, 2027

Summary of Webinar 2

Evaluation Process	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 80% of score is based on program narrative responses• 20% of score is based on budget details
Minimum Expectations to consider during program narrative completion	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Year 1: Stakeholders and community engagement, plan development• Year 2: Implementation plan• Year 3: Continued plan implementation while building sustainable practices and programs
Program Narrative Considerations	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Start with strengths-based approach• Provide details and cite data sources• Build off current community engagement and initiatives
Three-year Funding Allocations	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Year 1 – 100% with a maximum amount of \$100,000• Year 2 – 75% with a maximum amount of \$75,000 (25% grantee matching funds)• Year 3 – 50% with a maximum amount of \$50,000 (50% grantee matching funds)
Budget Considerations	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Must complete one per site• Be in alignment with program narrative responses• MOU Required – Consortia ONLY
Approximating Award Amount Formula	(Division) + (AI/AN % Tier) + (Proximity Tier) = Approximated Award Amount
