1	Meals served to non-Program adults were not priced appropriately to cover the cost of the meal at Moencopi Day School. Specifically, Lunch is priced \$3.75, when it should be priced \$4.15 according to adult meal price tool.	Discussed ways to determine adult meal prices which included a per meal cost analysis or pricing adult meals to reflect the amount of reimbursement received for a free meal plus the per meal value of donated foods.	Please provide a written description of the steps which have been taken to increase adult meal prices and resolve the discrepancy, including the exact formula used to price adult meals. Additionally, please submit supporting documentation which reflects that prices have been increased to the appropriate level.

Quantities observed during the review period did not meet minimum amounts required by the meal pattern. Specifically, weekly starchy subgroup was not met, only 1/4c was served instead of the required 1/2c. This was not a repeat finding from cycle two and did not contributed towards fiscal action calculations.
Discussed how current system allowed for this to happen and potential changes that could be made to ensure it doesn't continue (e.g., changes in serving utensils, recipes, etc.).

3 Meat/meat alternate was used to contribute toward the grain component at breakfast before the daily minimum grains requirement 1.0 ounce equivalent was met. Specifically, no grain was provided crediting as 0oz equivalent was served with 2oz equivalents of meat/meat alternate on June 6 at Moencopi Day School. This was not a repeat finding from cycle two and did not contributed towards fiscal action calculations.
