

AZELLA Placement Test Administration Compliance Time Frames

Placement Testing Timeline Process

- 1. **Identify** the eligible student (see <u>Eligibility for the AZELLA Placement Test</u> document)
- 2. **Register** the student for the Placement Test (through PearsonAccess^{next} (PAN))
- 3. Administer the Placement Test
- 4. Some grade levels must have their responses/scores **key entered** and submitted through PAN (Kindergarten, Grade 1, and Grades 2-3 Unit 4)
- 5. Wait for the OnDemand results (approximately 1-2 days after test was completed) that will be available in PAN
- 6. Notify parents of the results (Do NOT provide the parents/guardians with a copy of the OnDemand Report)

Clarifying "Time"

Calendar Days, Weeks, and Months	Every day on the calendar. This includes Saturdays, Sundays, holidays, and all non-instructional days.
Jump Start	Two calendar weeks before the first academic instructional day for students based on the School Finance approved district/charter calendar. These 2 weeks are bonus time. They are not included in the Start of School time.
Start of School	First academic day for students based on the School Finance approved district/charter calendar.
After School Starts	Begins with the second academic instructional day for students based on the School Finance approved district/charter calendar.
Enrollment Date	This is the day that the student enrolled in school as compared to the first day of attendance. They may or may not be the same day. The "enrollment date" is noted on various ADE reports, including the EL73 Report and the STUD10 Report. When students enroll before the first academic instructional day, their "enrollment date" is the first day of school.

Federal Funds v. No Federal Funds (Title I and/or Title III funds)

This is about **potential EL** students. These are students who are NEW to AZ schools and do NOT have an AZELLA test history nor EL program transactions per the EL70 Report.

Within 30 calendar days for students who are enrolled in school on (*or before) the first academic day of the school year, or within two (2) calendar weeks of the student's school enrollment for those who enroll in	Within 60 calendar days for students who are enrolled in school on (*or before) the first academic day of the school year, or within 30 calendar days of the student's school enrollment for those who enroll in school after	
school after the first day of instruction.	the first day of instruction.	
* The 30 calendar days does not start until the first academic day of the school year.	* The 60 calendar days does not start until the first academic day of the school year.	
The 30/60 days is only for those students who are enrolled in school by the first academic instructional day for the school year. This timeline does NOT restart as each student enrolls after the first day of school.		

Re-Testing EL Students with an AZELLA Placement Test

EL students with an AZELLA test history or an EL Program Services Enrollment who need to be administered a new AZELLA Placement Test must do so within 2 calendar weeks from the date of the student's school enrollment.

Students with an **UNDETERMINED** Spring 2023 Reassessment Test result. The <u>English Learner Status Undetermined or Missed Prior Reassessment Test</u> 2023-2024 referral form must be used for this student.

Students who missed the administration of the Spring 2023 Reassessment Test. The <u>English Learner Status</u> <u>Undetermined or Missed Prior Reassessment Test</u> 2023-2024 referral form must be used for this student.

Students with the ${\bf red}$ font ${\bf quick}$ alert ${\bf message}$ on their EL70 Report.

Students associated with **EL Group 8** on the school's EL73 Report.

Students will show up on the school's EL73 Report after their school enrollment has been synchronized with AzEDS.

Students with a Placement Test Referral.

Students who have an EL need, were administered the Spring 2023 Reassessment Test, and received an Overall Proficiency Level that is less than proficient (and not Undetermined) are not eligible to be administered a new Placement Test unless they are eligible for the EL to Mainstream Placement Test referral.

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
