- The crediting information recorded on the production record for breakfast on 6/5/23 is inaccurate. Specifically, the breakfast sausage bagel served credited as 1.0 oz eg meat/meat alternate, 2.0 oz eq grain, and 1/8 cup red/orange vegetable; however, the production record indicated it credited as 1.0 oz eg meat/meat alternate, 1.75 oz eg grain, and 1/8 cup vegetable.
- The crediting information recorded on the production record for breakfast on 6/8/23 is inaccurate. Specifically, the sausage, egg, and cheese biscuit served credited as 2.5 meat/meat alternate and 2.25 oz eq grain; however, the production record Crediting resources can be found on indicated it credited 2.0 oz eg meat/meat alternate and 2.0 oz eq grain.
- The production record for lunch on 6/7/23 was not completed correctly. Specifically, the serving size recorded for the chicken tenders was 3 tenders; however, 2 tenders were actually served. The crediting information recorded on the production record (2.0 oz eg meat/meat alternate and 1.0 oz eg grain) was accurate for the serving size of 2 tenders.
