Specifically, community children and children attending summer programming did not have the same access to meals at Window Rock High School. All children children enrolled in summer did not have the option to eat meals on-site or take meals to-go.

Counting & Claiming

Discussed that schools or sites participating under the SSO must changes to the system that will be ensure community children have the same access to meals as school. If meal service times are staggered, the same meal service must be provided to both groups, meaning the same food is served for the same length of time.
