
COLLEGE ACCESS PROFESSIONAL TRAINING

For counselors, educators and college access professionals.

CAP TRAINING COURSES – FAFSA AND FINANCIAL AID



• CAP Training Courses - FAFSA and Financial Aid Series

- Maximum of 15 seat hours
- 4-week courses
- Scholarship application built into the registration process

• Arizona Financial Aid Specialist Certificate

- Participants who complete the four financial aid courses will receive an Arizona Financial Aid Specialist certificate signifying that they have a mastery of knowledge and key strategies to support students and families with identifying/securing financial aid resources and with FAFSA completion. The four courses include:
 - Financial Aid I: Introduction to Financial Aid
 - Financial Aid II: Financial Aid Programs
 - Financial Aid III: The FAFSA Step-By-Step
 - Financial Aid IV: FAFSA Events, Comparing Offers, and Making Appeals

ARIZONA CACTUS LEAGUE PARTNERSHIP

• The Arizona Cactus League, the Arizona Board of Regents, and Ask Benji teamed up to encourage college-bound Arizona high school seniors to fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Students had to complete their FAFSA, and they could score (4) free Arizona Cactus League spring training tickets to a baseball game this season!

- > 829 Arizona high school seniors have received tickets to attend a 2023 spring training game season for completing their FAFSA
- > 400 entries submitted in the first week
- > 2% FAFSA Completion Rate increase in the overall statewide rate







FAFSA PEER COACH PROGRAM

- In Fall 2022, the Arizona Board of Regents recruited, trained, and deployed 108 FAFSA Peer Coaches to work with high school students in 24 high schools.
- ABOR's FAFSA Peer Coaches are current high school Seniors who support college application and FAFSA completion through positive influence and peer assistance.

 FAFSA Peer Coaches help at large-scale FAFSA events and provide 1:1 support for students and families. What do you believe you have added to the Peer Coach team? What are you most proud of?

"I believe I have added a sense of enthusiasm to the team. I'm most proud of our ability to express how important all of this really is for our futures. We are really getting that message across to the students in a manner where they are understanding its importance."

WHEREAS, reaching the state's attainment goal, Achieve60AZ, would position Arizona to reap significant financial and social benefits; and

WHEREAS, outreach and opportunities to encourage students to pursue education past high school will help increase educational attainment; and


WHEREAS, National College Signing Day, which originated in 2014 as part of the Reach Higher Initiative, celebrates all students committed to pursuing an education beyond high school and is a model that can create awareness for increased educational attainment in Arizona; and

WHEREAS, Arizona Decision Day, modeled after National College Signing Day, is a statewide initiative designed to celebrate and show support of students making decisions for their future and create awareness for increased educational attainment.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Katie Hobbs, Governor of the State of Arizona, do hereby proclaim May 1, 2023 as

ARIZONA DECISION DAY

and to commemorate and celebrate all students who take steps to advance their education after high school graduation, whether they plan to attend a community college or a four-year university; enroll in a certificate program, join the military, or any other education past high school.

ARIZONA DECISION DAY 2023

• Governor Hobbs declared May 1, 2023, as Arizona Decision Day. Additionally, ABOR created a toolkit to be used by educators that provided ideas to celebrate Arizona High School Senior's college-going plans. High Schools from Cochise County to Coconino County took time to recognize the big decisions A7 students made.



The Arizona College Application Campaign (AzCAC) is a statewide effort to increase the number of first-generation college students and students from low-income families pursuing a college degree or other higher education credential. Through this program, high schools are stepping up to advise and guide seniors and their families through their college application journey.

AzCAC is designed to encourage schools to support graduating seniors navigate the admissions process and provide students the opportunity to complete at least one college application during the school year. AzCAC can open the door for students by encouraging them to take significant steps toward college in their senior year and ultimately ensure that every student has a chance to reach their potential and bring Arizona closer to 60% postsecondary attainment by 2030.

AzCAC is an initiative of the Arizona Board of Regents and is part of the American College Application Campaign.
