


# October 1 Data Collection Flow Chart




**Phase I**  
**PERSONNEL & CENSUS VERIFICATION**

- Student count and FTE of personnel serving SPED students



**Phase II**  
**RECONCILIATION**

- PEAs upload data into AzEDS
- Data should align with phase 1 submission



**Phase III**  
**NON-RECONCILIATION**

- PEAs submit reason(s) for non-reconciliation.

**Phase I**  
**Verification count, personnel data, and electronic signature are due by**  
**November 15, 2023**

**Phase II**  
**Reconciliation is due by**  
**January 24, 2024**

**Phase III**  
**Non-Reconciliation is due by**  
**April 24, 2024**

# October 1 Data Collection (ODC) Phase I - Verification

- Step 1:
  - A yearly federal reporting requirement
  - Report an unduplicated count of students ages 3 – 21 receiving SPED services over October 1.
  - Report full-time equivalent (FTE) personnel data for teachers, paraprofessionals, and related service providers.
- Step 2:
  - Complete with an Electronic Signature by the LEA Signer

## **If October 1 falls on a non-session day - Student is included if**

Enrolled on last day school was in session before October 1.

**AND**

Continued receiving SPED services on the first day school was in session following October 1.


### **Who counts the student?**

The PEA where the student was enrolled PRIOR to October 1.

**Data Management Alert: When October 1 Falls on a non-session day.**

\*Verify the date by using the school calendar approved by ADE found on the AzEDS Portal.

# Helpful Tips

- Utilize the resources found on the ESS Data Management website
  - October 1 Data Collection Manual
    - October 1 Checklist
    - October 1 Do's & Don'ts
- Use student rosters
- Ask every teacher to conduct a head count of all students receiving SPED services on October 1
- Query your Student Information System (SIS)
- Work with your Human Resource Director (Personnel Data)
- Any method that works for you
- Do **NOT** rely on AzEDS data!

# Trending Topics – Ancillary Services

- A.R.S. § 15-769 (D)

D. If a pupil with a group B disability **does not receive special education instructional** services but receives at least one ancillary service, the pupil shall be considered a special education pupil for the group B funding. If the category of disability has both a resource and self-contained weight, the pupil shall be classified as in a resource program. For the purposes of this subsection, "ancillary service" means one of the following:

1. Physical therapy.
2. Occupational therapy.
3. Orientation and mobility training.
4. Sign language interpretation services.
5. A full-time aide needed for an individual pupil to benefit from the pupil's educational program as specified in the pupil's individualized education program.

# Trending Topics – Ancillary Services

- Students **NOT** on an IEP
  - Must have a Group B disability
    - Autism
    - Hearing Impairment
    - Multiple Disabilities
    - Multiple Disabilities – Severe Sensory Impairment
    - Moderate Intellectual Disability
    - Orthopedic Impairment
    - Preschool Severe Delay
    - Severe Intellectual Disability
    - Visual Impairment

# Trending Topics – Ancillary Services

- Students **NOT** on an IEP
  - Example: Student with severe hearing loss may require sign language interpreter services.
  - Student reporting:
    - Need: HI
    - Identify Need as 'IsAncillary'
    - LRE L: Ancillary services provided for Students not on an IEP.
  - Once reported, student will be funded with applicable Group B weight.

# Trending Topics – Ancillary Services

A.R.S. § 15-769 (D)

5. A full-time aide needed for an individual pupil to benefit from the pupil's educational program as specified in the pupil's individualized education program.

- Student **on an IEP**

- Must have a full-time aide intended for the entire school day
  - Must have a group B disability
  - Report applicable Need
  - Identify Need as 'IsAncillary'
  - Report applicable LRE. Do NOT report LRE L
- Once reported, student will be funded with applicable Group B weight.

# Trending Topics – Ancillary Services

- A.R.S. § 15-769 (D)

D. If a pupil with a group B disability does not receive special education instructional services but receives at least one ancillary service, the pupil shall be considered a special education pupil for the group B funding. **If the category of disability has both a resource and self-contained weight, the pupil shall be classified as in a resource program.**

# Top 3 Integrity Errors – Steps for Solving

Step 1: Check Integ15 report to figure out the error

Step 2: Pull up the integrity error tool to assist in solving the error

Step 3: Review the relevant reports in the AzEDS portal to locate the issue

Step 4: Make the changes necessary and check the STUD10 and the SPED10 within a few minutes of syncing to AzEDS to see if the data landed as you expected. Integrity will run overnight.

# Top 3 Integrity Errors

## Integrity Error -40069

- Error Message:
  - Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) must be within a valid enrollment at a school. Please note the error may be caused by a student not having valid enrollment due to missing DOR, grade or calendar
- Common Issue At This Time:
  - Gaps in Enrollment and LRE
- Possible Solution:
  - LRE entry and exit dates should fall within enrollment entry and exit dates

# Top 3 Integrity Errors

## Integrity Error -40004

- Error Message:
  - The Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) code, grade, or need combination does not comply with the Concurrent Need and Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) Code Eligibility matrix
- Common Issue At This Time:
  - LRE's intended for Preschool are being used for Kindergarten
- Possible Solution:
  - Review the [Concurrent Need and LRE Code Matrix](#)

# Top 3 Integrity Errors

## Integrity Error -40076

- Error Message:
  - SPED Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) Exit Date with Exit Code SPED13 must only be reported on the last in-session day of the reported calendar.
- Common Issue At This Time:
  - Using SPED13 to end SPED and it's not the end of the school year.
- Possible Solution:
  - Choose a different SPED exit code that is relevant to the student leaving SPED or enrollment.
  - Review [AzEDS SPED Codes](#) for a refresher on SPED exit codes.
