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ACHIEVEMENT TUTORING

STATE TUTORING

- Uses ESSER3 funds
- Only for this school year

- Any LEA not rated D or F can participate
- Tutoring preferred in groups of three

Uses Arizona funding

Ongoing

Only for schools rated D or F

Tutoring only in groups of three



ACHIEVEMENT TUTORING GOALS

Improve proficiency in reading, writing, and math for students in grades 4-8

Prepare students in grades 1-3 to test proficient in reading, writing, and math when they take the AASA exam spring of their 3rd grade year



ELIGIBILITY

SUBJECTS

Grades 1-3: All Students

Reading

- Grades 4-8: Only students that tested below proficient on the 2023 AASA
- Writing
- Math

LEAs are responsible for verifying eligibility

TUTORING SESSIONS

Up to 60-minute sessions

Up to three students maximum

Up to four days per week

Small groups of three preferred

For six-week sessions

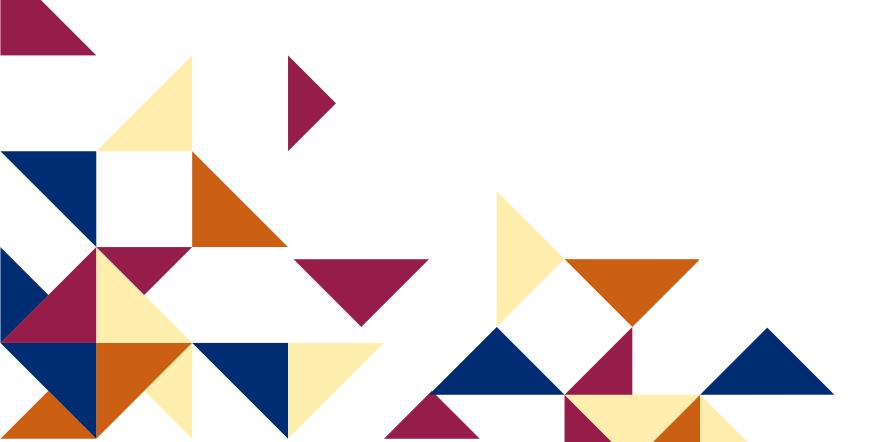

FUNDING

- LEAs get 30% of tutoring hours to pay for administration of the program
 - Funds may be used for tutor benefits, administration of program salaries, transportation, printing, etc.
- Teachers get paid by LEA \$40.00/hour
- LEAs will invoice a third-party vendor on a monthly basis
- LEAs will distribute funds to teacher tutors



ACCOUNTABILITY

- Achievement Tutoring Portal on ADE Connect
 - LEAs upload student SSID number and date of birth
 - Portal collects pre-test and post-test data
 - Tutors sign in and log hours
 - LEA attestation of hours
- Tutors will administer ADE approved pre-test and post-test for each six-week session
- LEAs will have an ATP Designee Test Coordinator
