The Early Intervention and Early Childhood Special Education Summit is an annual event cohosted by Arizona Department of Education's Exceptional Student Services Early Childhood Special Education Unit and the Department of Economic Security's Arizona Early Intervention Program. It is designed to present content related to supporting children with disabilities, ages 0–5, by bringing national speakers, state staff, and local practitioners together to share information about issues, challenges, successes, practices, and strategies to improve outcomes. This year, the Summit will take place over three days, with Day One focused on presenting the state of early childhood, the results, and the research around key issues. The following two days will be focused on evidence-based practices, supports, and successes. Day Two will highlight effective practices when working with children in early intervention. Day Three will showcase strategies and best practices when working with children in preschool settings.
