Friday Focus Webinar – AASA Paper-Based Testing October 27, 2023

Will Grade 3 students in paper-based testing schools be assigned to online Oral Reading Fluency (ORF) sessions in PearsonAccess^{next}?

In Spring 2024, all Grade 3 students will take the Oral Reading Fluency (ORF) test unit online in TestNav, including students in paper-based testing schools. The telephone test has been discontinued. As such, all Grade 3 students in paper-based testing schools will be added to online ORF sessions in PearsonAccess^{next} when they are uploaded to the platform.

When must AASA paper-based test booklets be returned to Pearson for scoring?

Paper-Based Testing (PBT) schools must return materials to Pearson immediately following the PBT test window. The Spring 2024 PBT test window is April 1 – 10, 2024. Materials must be picked up by UPS by April 11, 2024.
