SEAP Analysis Request – Arizona State Board of Education June 2023

Area of Focus:

1. Age of Transition Planning for Students with Disabilities

Issue:

1. Currently, secondary transition planning for students with disabilities begins at age 16; however, this does not always leave sufficient time for effective planning or for revision to plans as a student approaches graduation from high school.

Proposal:

1. To change the age of secondary transition planning for students to 14.

Key Questions:

- 1. Is this allowable under IDEA?
- 2. Are there any concerns from the SPED community about this prospective change?
- 3. Are there concerns from LEAs about this prospective change?
- 4. What other states have made a similar change? What advice would they give?

Possible Solutions:

- 1. Rulemaking
 - a. The SBE can open rulemaking related to special education and add rules that change the age of transition planning for Arizona from 16 to 14.
