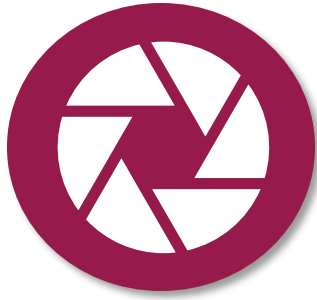

Create and maintain **relationships** between ADE and Indigenous communities to drive positive change for Native American students

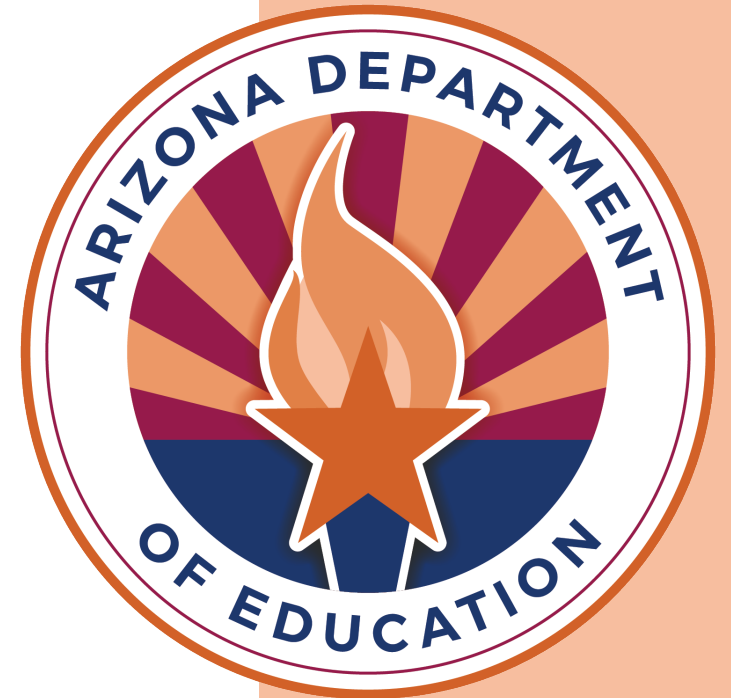

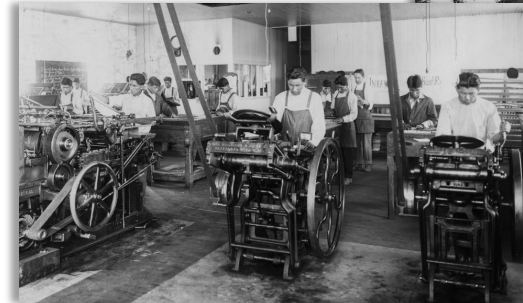

- Visiting 5 distinct landmarks across the phoenix metropolitan area







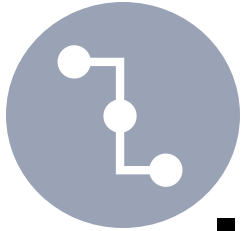
