How to Register

- Step 1: Visit the Law for Kids website: https://lawforkids.org/ssp-training
- Step 2: Create an account or login to proceed
- **Step 3:** Click the training that will meet your <u>annual training requirement</u>
- **Step 4:** Select the date you wish you attend and register to be sent a confirmation email
- **Step 5:** Open your confirmation email and follow the instructions to complete the registration process

NOTE: Training attendance is directly linked to the name of the person who registered for the training. Thus, **each person must register separately to ensure they receive their own training link.** To receive full credit for attending the training, you must login using your own training link and your own device. Devices must have functional audio and video to receive credit for training. *Failure to meet your annual training requirement can result in your school district/charter being placed on programmatic hold next year.*

Before the Training

Pre-work is required for some trainings, and it must be completed prior to attending the training. You will find information and links to any **pre-work in your confirmation email**.

Leadership 100

Leadership 100 walks participants through the philosophy and requirements of the program and the key roles and responsibilities of the participants. This training sets a foundation for multi-disciplinary team-based approaches, data-based decision making, as well as best practices for school safety. Participants will learn how activities of Officers, Counselors, and Social Workers are connected to school safety and comprehensive efforts to drive your program. Finally, participants will locate helpful tools, supports, and

resources.

During this training, participants will engage in purposeful activities, have opportunities for asking questions, and network with other school communities.

<u>All Schools</u>: Required to attend a virtual, full-day, live, interactive training.

Who Attends? All the following who are NEW to the program in FY 2024 or who joined the program during FY 2023 but did not attend Leadership 100 training in that year:

- District Administrator
- Site Administrator (Principal and/or Principal's Designee*, if applicable)
- Agency Supervisor

*If a principal appoints a designee (assistant principal, dean of students, etc.) to oversee the School Safety Program, both the principal and the designee must attend Leadership 100. Thereafter, the designee can attend Advanced Leadership Training on behalf of the principal. If there is turnover in either position, the continuing administrator must ensure that the current year's training requirement is met. The new administrator must attend Leadership 100 training.

New Counselor & Social Worker (CSW) Training

This is a two-day training: Day 1 is Leadership 100 and Day 2 is specific to CSWs. On Day 1, CSWs join Leadership 100 with other grantees (administrators, CSWs, and officers) to learn about the School Safety Program's philosophy, requirements, roles and responsibilities, and school safety related topics. On Day 2, CSWs attend with their peers to clarify program requirements, share tools to meet those requirements, and spend time sharing resources and building collaborative connections with other CSWs.

Note: All Counselors and Social Workers will register for both trainings under CSW in the law for kids website. It is *one registration link for both days*. **Do not** register separately for Leadership 100. Registering for New CSW Training will automatically register you for Leadership 100.

New Officer Trainings (NOT)

This four-day in person workshop covers community-oriented policing, the role of the school-based officers, and an introduction to Law Related Education (LRE) as an essential prevention tool. Day 1 begins with Leadership 100, where School Resource Officers and Juvenile Probation Officers attend training with other grantees (administrators, CSWs, and officers). Day 2 covers child and brain development, trauma-informed practices, and best practices for officers in schools. Days 3 and 4 take participants on a deep dive into Law Related Education, providing officers with classroom management techniques, space to share ideas and lesson plans, and knowledge of learning styles. Day 4 will also include working with students in special education. Officers leave with resources and tools ready to teach in the classroom.

Please NOTE: All Officers will register for both New Officer Training and Leadership 100 in the Law for Kids website under "New Officer Training". It is ONE registration for all four days. Do not register separately for Leadership 100. Registering for New Officer Training will automatically register you for Leadership 100.

This workshop focuses on reducing bullying behaviors school-wide through explicit instruction and deeper understanding of the bullying construct. Participants will gain understanding of how to remove the reinforcers that maintain socially aggressive behaviors, discuss how to positively impact bystander behavior, and how to teach all students to correctly identify and interrupt disrespectful and unkind behavior. Additional resources that provide understanding of the form and function of bullying behavior will be provided to each attendee.
