Superintendent's Annual Report

- ARS 15-255 requires ADE to submit a report to the governor and legislature each year and defines the information that must be included.
- The Superintendent's Annual Report largely compiles district and charter data from the School Finance new budget and payment systems, but also includes information from counties, state agency and other ADE units.

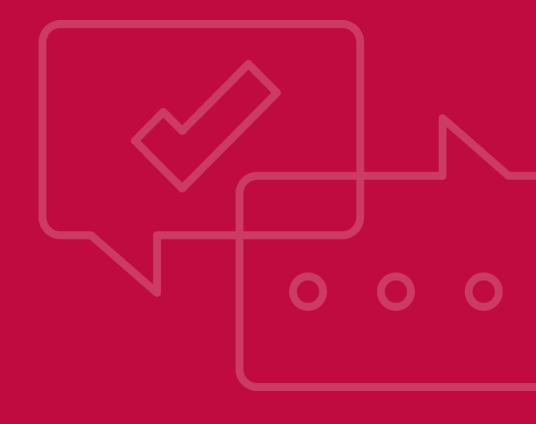

 - Districts that fail to submit vehicle inventory will not have TSL calculated for FY2025.
