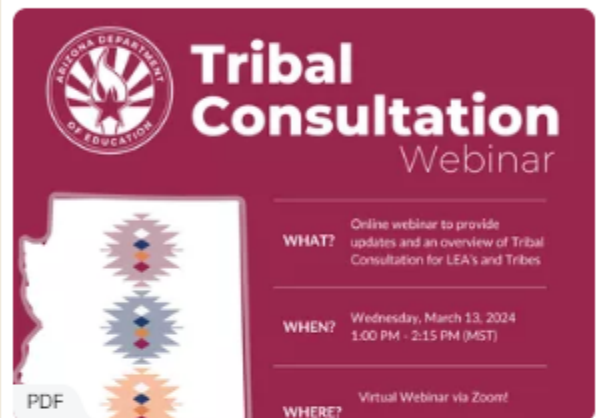
Program Overview

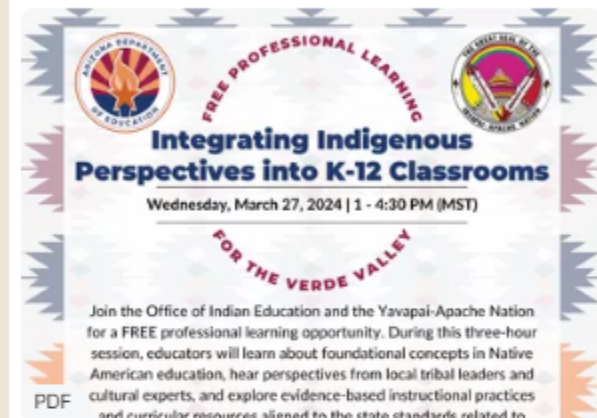

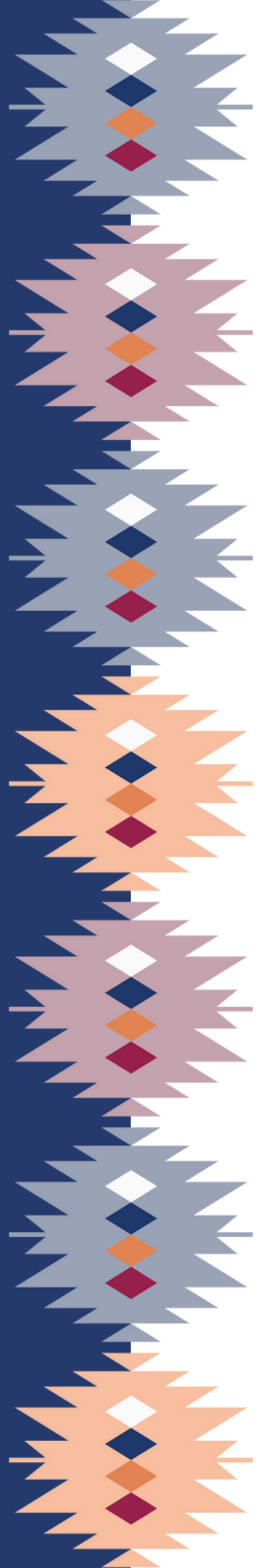
