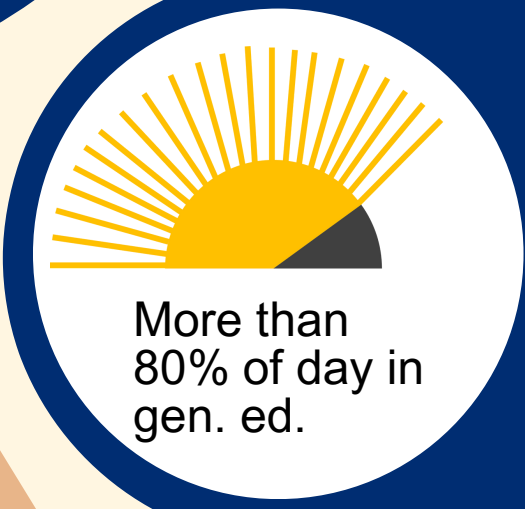


# Educational Environments for Children with Disabilities

Data regarding school-aged children with IEPs (age 5 and in kindergarten through age 21) during the 2022–2023 school year.

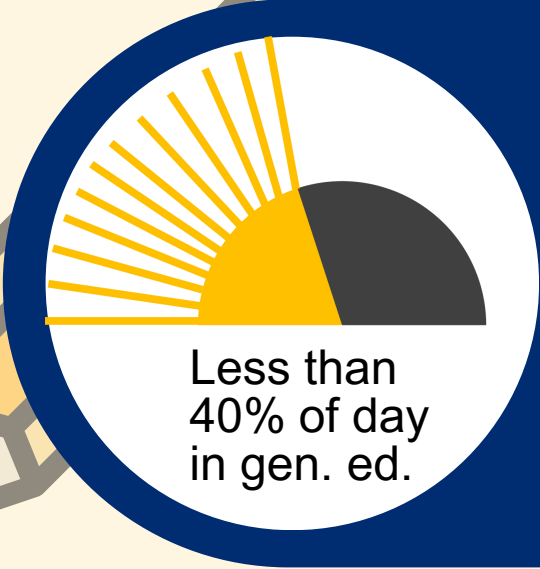
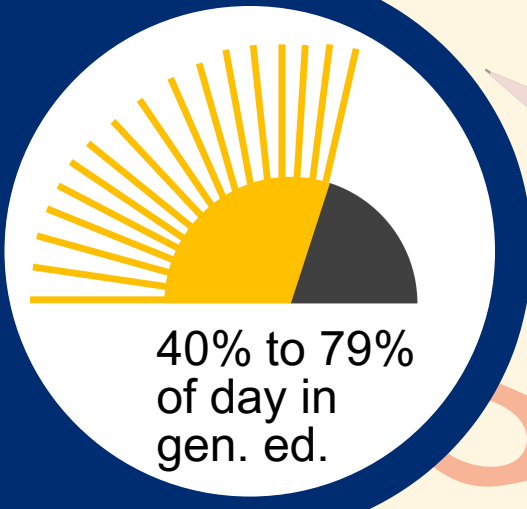


**69.1%**

of school-aged children with IEPs were served inside the general education classroom 80% or more of the school day, compared to the national average at 67%.

**15.5%**

of school-aged children with IEPs were served inside the general education classroom less than 80% but more than 40% of the school day, compared to the national average at 20.1%.



**12.8%**

of school-aged children with IEPs were served inside the general education classroom 40% or less of the school day, compared to the national average at 12.5%.

**2.6%**

of school-aged children with IEPs were served in separate schools, residential facilities, or homebound/hospital placements, compared to the national average at 3.4%.
