Implementation Site Leadership Team

- Attend a 2-day Leadership Academy, in addition to practitioner content training around the Pyramid Model practices.

Implement systems of the Pyramid Model program-wide for three to five years, around training, practice-based coaching, data collection and use, and a Leadership Team. This will be accomplished through structures of support provided from the AZ Pyramid Model SLT.

Work in collaboration with the SLT, Trainers, and Program Coaches to ensure implementation fidelity.

Establish a Leadership Team that meets on a monthly basis and includes the Practitioner Coach and a member that will serve as Data Coordinator. The site level Leadership Team will receive support from a Program Coach to guide implementation steps.

Commit to the participation of the site level Leadership Team in 6 days of meetings/trainings (if those members have not already received these trainings): 1-2 days of Leadership Academy and 3-4 days of Pyramid Model content training.

Collect and use evaluation data to guide program-wide implementation, support practitioner implementation, and monitor child progress and outcomes.

Send program staff and Practitioner Coaches to three days of content training around Pyramid Model practices (if these staff members have not already received these trainings).

Identify Practitioner Coaches to participate in coaching support from the external Program Coach, in addition to participating in 4 additional days of training, including Practice Based Coaching (2days) and TPOT or TPITOS Training (2 days), if these staff members have not already received these trainings.

Begin to or continue entering data into the Pyramid Innovation Data System (PIDS).
