Re: Moderate/Severe Special Education Certification

In 2019, Private Special Education (SPED) Schools were given a temporary exception allowing certified special education teachers with two years of experience in a mild/moderate special education classroom to provide services in a moderate/severe special education classroom. This exception will expire on June 30, 2024.

New and existing Private SPED Schools will be required to follow the updated Certification
Matrix for Fiscal Year 25. If a Private SPED School is unable to hire a moderate/severe certified teacher by July 1, 2024, appropriate personnel will be required to submit supporting documentation that they are making an effort to appropriately certify teachers. Private SPED Schools that do not meet this requirement will be allowed a one-year transition period if supporting documentation is provided.

The pathway to become qualified to teach in moderate/severe SPED classroom will depend on the teacher's educational background. Please refer to the <u>Special Education Certification</u> <u>Pathways guide</u>.

- If a teacher does not have the required three years of full-time teaching and
 prerequisite certificate, they will need to enroll in an alternative program and apply for
 the Alternative Teaching certificate. Please refer to the list of approved Moderate/Severe
 programs below.
- If a teacher has the prerequisite certificate and teaching experience, they qualify
 for the Provisional or Full Moderate/Severe endorsement. Please refer to the list of
 approved Moderate/Severe programs below. The courses may also be found at other
 colleges and universities; however, teachers should confirm that the college or
 university will verify completion of the required practicum in moderate/severe SPED
 before enrolling.
